Anointing of the Sick - In case of serious illness (or advanced age), please call the priests.

Hospital cases should contact the Chaplain, but the Parish Office should be notified so one of the priests may visit the patient.



A MESSAGE FROM YOUR PASTOR

My dear parishioners,

This weekend's celebration of the Epiphany of Our Lord reminds us that the wondrous mystery of Christmas is not to be put away too soon, along with the decorations and gifts we've received. The message that God is with us in Jesus must be treasured in our hearts because we must continue to see how it gives

hope to our lives.

Today with the Epiphany we see that the manifestation of God's love was meant for all peoples, not just the people of Israel. But the way those first Gentiles discovered Jesus was through the light and guidance of a star, shining in the darkness. This great feast reminds us that we are called to be those guiding lights to lead others to Jesus.

In many ways, our world is engulfed in darkness. One place we see its effect is in our young people. So many have bought into the modern philosophy of, "Who needs religion? Who needs God? Who needs Mass and the sacraments?" They think that they have all they need to be happy, without God. They need a star to guide them.

That is one of the main reasons why our Parish Staff and I introduced what we call "**Families of Faith Initiative.**" It is meant to be a way of supporting families of faith in today's secularized culture.

We started off back in November with a talk, followed by questions and answers with a group of missionary young adults called the Culture Project. The evening was well attended and gave parents a glimpse into the challenges they face trying to be "stars" who will lead their children to Christ and His Church.



On Wednesday Jan. 25 at 7:00pm we offer Part Two. This will begin the process of searching together with the help of parent speakers, the best practices strategies and means of mutual support for Catholic parents, grandparents, teachers and catechists. How do we accompany young people in making moral decisions and enlighten them to the importance of the Sacraments? This second meeting will again be held in our Parish Hall/Cafeteria.

On this Solemnity of the Epiphany, I place this initiative in the hands of our Blessed Mother and St. Joseph her spouse. For once the Three Magi saw the house over which the star remained, it was they who opened the door and showed them their Child Jesus. Through the intercession of Mary and Joseph, may this Families of Faith Initiative help us all to lead our young people closer to Jesus, our Savior.



The Catholic Relief Services (CRS) collection funds Catholic agencies that work for the benefit of our brothers and sisters around the world who are marginalized and in critical need of assistance. By providing humanitarian aid, resettling those displaced by warfare or strife, and advocating on behalf of victims of atrocities such as human trafficking, beneficiaries of the CRS collection fulfill the Church's mission of mercy.

They respond affirmatively to the Gospel's call to love others as we love God and proclaim our fundamental belief that every human life is sacred in a concrete way.

The annual Catholic Relief Services collection challenges American Catholics to put their faith into action and to see the presence of Christ in the faces of the poor and to demonstrate love for Christ by responding to their needs. A small amount from the collection is retained by the Archdiocese to help cover local efforts to promote the collection.

This year's collection will be taken up in the parishes of the Archdiocese of Philadelphia during the weekend of January 14-15, 2023. The American Catholic community, and the Archdiocese of Philadelphia in particular, have always responded very generously to this annual collection. The majority of funds collected support relief efforts overseas and a small amount is retained locally for charitable endeavors undertaken by our local Church.



Cornerstone for Life

Abortion leading cause of death in 2022

More human beings died in abortions than any other cause of death in 2022.

A heartbreaking reminder about the prevalence of abortion, statistics compiled by Worldometers indicate that there were over 44 million abortions world-wide in 2022. The independent site collects data from governments and other organizations and then reports the data, along with estimates and projections, based on those numbers.

Worldometers bases its daily abortion figures on a fact sheet from the World Health Organization, which estimates an even higher figure for abortions per year than Worldometers. "Around 73 million induced abortions take place worldwide

each year," the WHO says.

Abortion is also the leading cause of death in the United States. "In the USA, where nearly 30% of pregnancies are unintended and 40% of these are terminated by abortion, there are between 1,500 to 2,500 abortions per day. Nearly 20% of all pregnancies in the USA (excluding miscarriages) end in abortion. Guttmacher Institute reports 930,160 abortions performed in 2020 in the United States, with a rate of 14.4 per 1,000 women," Worldometers reports. (Courtesy of LifeNews)


