## A MESSAGE FROM YOUR PASTOR

My dear parishioners,

On the first Sunday of Advent on Nov. 27, my recent appointment by Archbishop Nelson Pérez as a Regional Dean became effective. As my parishioners I want you to know what that appointment entails, and how it will impact St. Bede Parish.

First of all I am still the Pastor of your parish. This is just an additional assignment that while it adds to my priestly responsibilities, I feel certain will not impact our parish or me all that much. This is a time in the history of the Church when, because of fewer vocations to the priesthood, our priests are called to take on dual assignments or, to say it another way, "wear another hat."

The Regional Dean of which there are now 12 in the Archdiocese assists the Archbishop by sharing in the pastoral care and governance of our local church. They do so in dedicated geographic areas called "Deaneries."

In my case, I have been appointed the Dean of Central and Upper Bucks County, and so I am responsible for 22 parishes, including, of course, our own. The area is vast and extends from places like St. Lawrence Parish in Riegelsville, all the way down to Assumption Parish in Feasterville. Included in between are all the parishes in places like Doylestown, Warminster, Warrington, Sellersville, New Hope, Yardley, Morrisville and those of course near us.

Included in the responsibilities of the Dean and his Deanery is to visit about three parishes each year and meet with the priests, deacons, pastoral and finance councils of each parish. And by these visits I am to assist the Archbishop in his knowledge of the strengths and challenges of each parish. The Dean is to help provide support

and care to the clergy, and to see how each priest is doing.

Each Deanery will establish a Regional Deanery Council, whose purpose is to advise the Regional Dean about pastoral matters and concerns pertaining to the Deanery. As Dean I will also serve on the Priest's Personnel Board, which advises the Archbishop when appointments and transfers of priests are considered.

The encouraging truth about this new appointment is that many of these responsibilities I have already been doing over these past six years, as Dean of the same area, having been elected years ago by my fellow priests. Now by appointment, I foresee as I said earlier in this column minimal impact on my presence here and my availability to serve you, my parishioners. Archbishop Pérez will be the first to say to all of us Deans (who by the way except one, are pastor): "Remember, your parish comes first."

That is how I have lived my vocation and appointment as pastor of St. Bede, and how I intend, with God's assistance, to continue. Thank you, my dear people, for your prayers, understanding, support and love.

May God bless you.

### Monthly-Story of Our Lady- Our



**Lady of Lourdes:** Our Lady of Lourdes is probably one of the most well know apparitions of Mary in all of history. She came to a small French town called none other than Lourdes. Lourdes is French for "craggy slope." The town is right on the river below a sloped mountain, off set in the distance by the beautiful French Pyrene Mountains. In 1858, the world was changed forever because God ordained that Mary would come and visit a peasant girl named Bernadette

Soubirous daily for 40 days say: "*I am the Immaculate Conception.*" It all started on Thursday, February 11, 1858, fourteen-year-old Bernadette was sent with her younger sister and a friend to gather firewood, when Our Lady appeared to her above a rose bush in a grotto called Massabielle (Tuta de Massavielha). On February 25, Our Lady told Bernadette "to drink of the water of the spring, to wash in it and to eat the herb that grew there" as an act of penance. The next day, the grotto's muddy waters had been cleared and fresh clear water flowed. On March 2, at the thirteenth of the apparitions, Bernadette told her family the lady said "a chapel should be built and a procession formed."

Since Bernadette first dug in the ground and caused the spring to produce clean water, 69 cures have been verified by the Lourdes Medical Bureau, and after what the Church claimed were "extremely rigorous scientific and medical examinations," no one was able to explain what caused the cures. Now every February 11, Our Lady of Lourdes is celebrated along with the World Day for the Sick. (Catholic Online) So if you are need a healing, ask Our Lady of Lourdes to help you or those in need.

St Bede Cross Country team celebrated year end party on Sat Nov 12<sup>th</sup>.



We finished up season at Archdiocese champs meet on Sunday Oct 30<sup>th</sup> at Belmont, with over 70 other parishes, where we did very well and the competition was fierce. We had 4 medalists: Alex Smith (9<sup>th</sup> of 168), Mia LaFrado (13<sup>th</sup> of 109), Emily Rhodes (12<sup>th</sup> of 78), and Finn Malone (9<sup>th</sup> of 127).
