A MESSAGE FROM YOUR PASTOR

My dear parishioners,

We've come to the fourth and final Sunday of Advent! Throughout this holy season we have heard St. John the Baptist and the prophets reminding us to put our house in order, and do not let anything, even the many details of Christmas dinner and gift giving, break your resolve to follow Christ.

Confession is an encounter with Christ, with our sins and our need to change. We may say, "I have confessed the same sins over and over." If so you are in good company. For even the great saints of the Church wrote how they humbly returned to confession with the same list. It does not mean that you are not sorry, nor willing to begin again. Coming to confession is an opportunity Jesus gives us though to start over, yet again. His mercy endures forever!

St. John the Evangelist in his first letter, chapter, 1, verse 18 writes, "If we say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves and the truth is not in us." The Sacrament of Confession, after a thorough Examination of Conscience (which I provide on page 4 of this bulletin) reminds us of the truth that we have sinned.

But why confess our sins to a priest? He is a human and a sinner, like us. Remember, all healings involve other people. Doctors and nurses for physical healing, counselors and psychiatrists for mental wellness, and so on. Just because they may contract the same illness or deal with the same problems we do does not disqualify them from being an agent God uses of healing. So too with the

priest, who can sympathize and understand your struggles more than you know. Yes, just like doctors go to doctors for healing, we priests go to confession as well.

Since all sins have two dimensions, namely that we have offended God and someone in the community, so too do priests represent the good God and the community, who both have been injured. It is in their name that he, the priest, forgives.

This coming **Monday, Dec. 19** we have a perfect opportunity for the reception of the Sacrament of Reconciliation when we will have ten priests available. Mark it down in your calendar right now – it may be the best thing you do to celebrate the birth of Jesus Christ, by allowing Him to be reborn in you.

May God bless you.

Your grace, to sin no more and to
Avoid the near occasion of sin.*

Examination of Conscience

1. I AM THE LORD YOUR GOD. YOU SHALL NOT HAVE STRANGE GODS BEFORE ME.

- Do I give God time every day in prayer?
- Do I seek to love Him with my whole heart?
- Have I been involved in witchcraft, superstition or black magic?
- Have I received Communion in a state of mortal sin?
- Have I deliberately told a lie in Confession or withheld a mortal sin in Confession?

2. YOU SHALL NOT TAKE THE NAME OF THE LORD YOUR GOD IN VAIN.

- Did I curse or swear? Did I use God's name in vain, lightly, carelessly, by blasphemy?
- Have I wished evil upon another person?
- Have I been angry with God and stayed in that state of anger?
- Have I insulted a sacred person or abused a sacred object?

3. REMEMBER TO KEEP HOLY THE LORD'S DAY.

- Have I deliberately missed Mass on Sundays or Holy Days of obligation?
- Did I receive Holy Communion in the state of serious (mortal) sin?
- Have I tried to observe Sunday as a family day and a day of rest? Do I get enough rest or am I constantly running?
- Do I do needless work on Sunday?

4. HONOR YOUR FATHER AND YOUR MOTHER.

- Do I honor and obey my parents? Am I respectful towards them?
- Have I neglected my duties to my spouse and children?
- Have I given my family good religious example and try to bring peace into the home?
- Do I care for my aged and infirmed relatives?

5. YOU SHALL NOT KILL.

- Have I had an abortion or encouraged anyone to have an abortion?
- Have I mutilated myself through any form of sterilization? Have I encouraged or condoned sterilization?
- Have I harbored anger or resentment or hatred in my heart?
- Have I physically harmed anyone? Have I driven recklessly (too fast, showing off, etc.)?
- Have I abused alcohol or drugs?
- Have I hurt myself through cutting, scratching, or in any other way?
- Have I bullied or destroyed someone's reputation on social media?

6. YOU SHALL NOT COMMIT ADULTERY.

- Have I been faithful to my marriage vows in thought and action? Have I engaged in any sexual activity outside of marriage?
- Has each sexual act in my marriage been open to the transmission of new life?
- Have I engaged in any type of sexual activity (intercourse, oral sex, inappropriate touching, mutual masturbation)?
- Have I been guilty of masturbation? Have I entertained lustful thoughts?
- Have I been guilty of any homosexual activity?
- Do I seek to be chaste in my thoughts, words, and actions?
- Was I "immodest" in the way I dressed, acted or spoke (leading others to arousal)?
- Are my words, texts and photos on Facebook and/or other social media sites sexually charged?
- Did I look at pornography or visit chat rooms that were inappropriate?

7. YOU SHALL NOT STEAL.

- Have I stolen what is not mine?
- Have I returned or made restitution for what I have stolen?
- Did I waste time at work (which is really stealing from the company)?
- Do I gamble excessively, thereby denying my family of their needs?
- Do I seek to share what I have with the poor?

8. YOU SHALL NOT BEAR FALSE WITNESS AGAINST YOUR NEIGHBOR.

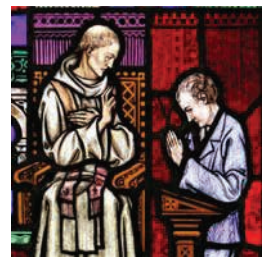
- Have I lied? Have I gossiped? Have I spoken behind someone else's back?
- Do I always tell the truth? Did I reveal secrets that should have been kept confidential?
- Am I sincere in my dealings with others?
- Am I critical, negative, or uncharitable in my thoughts of others?
- Do I keep secret what should be kept confidential?
- Is what I write in my emails, IM's, text messages or on any social media sites true about myself or others?

9. YOU SHALL NOT DESIRE YOUR NEIGHBOR'S WIFE.

- Have I consented to impure thoughts?
- Have I caused impure thoughts by impure reading, movies, conversations or curiosity?
- Do I seek to control my imagination?
- Do I pray at once to banish impure thoughts and temptations?

10. YOU SHALL NOT DESIRE YOUR NEIGHBOR'S GOODS.

- Am I jealous of what other people have? Do I envy the families or possessions of others?
- Am I greedy or selfish? Are material possessions the purpose of my life?

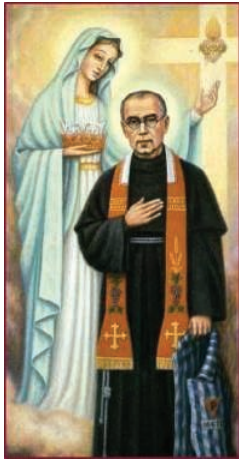
Dear parishioners,
