A MESSAGE FROM YOUR PASTOR

My dear parishioners,

As you know, I usually share good news with you in this column, generally about some of the many activities and ministries that are the essential ways we achieve our parish mission - that is to proclaim the Gospel of Christ. Today on this weekend on which we celebrate the exact day of Christmas Eve and Christmas Day, I feel compelled to reflect on the greatest news of all – the birthday of Jesus Christ.

My comments are borrowed from the homily Pope Francis preached last year at the 2021 Christmas Eve Mass in St. Peter's Basilica. Pope Francis began with the surprising news of the angel to the shepherd: *"You will find a child wrapped in swaddling clothes, lying in a feeding trough for animals, called a manger."* That is the sign: a child lying in the poverty of a manger.

The Gospel the Holy Father pointed out emphasizes the contrast between Caesar Augustus, the first Emperor in all of his splendor in Rome, and there in Bethlehem a small child, shivering in the cold. This is where God is in littleness. Littleness is the path that He chose to draw near to us. To touch our hearts. To save us and to bring us back to what really matters.

Let us be amazed by this "scandalous" truth – the One who embraces the universe needs to be held in another's arms. The One who created the sun needs to be warmed by His mother. Tenderness Incarnate needs to be cuddled. Infinite Love has a miniscule infant's heart that beats softly. The Eternal Word is a speechless child. The Bread of Life needs himself to be nourished.

Today on Christmas all is turned upside-down. God's grandeur appears in littleness. Let us ask ourselves, can we accept God's way of doing things? This is the challenge of Christmas, and of the entire Gospel. This is what we should ask Jesus for as we receive Him in Holy Communion: the grace of littleness.

What does that mean concretely, to accept littleness so as

to find true greatness? In the first place it means to believe that God desires to dwell in the little things of our life. He wants to inhabit our daily lives, the things we do each day at home, with our families, in school and in the workplace. Amid our ordinary lives, He wants to do extraordinary things.

His is a message of immense hope. Jesus asks us to re-discover the little things of life. If Jesus is present there, what else do we need? Let us stop pining for a grandeur that is not ours to have. Let us put aside our complaints and our gloomy faces, and the greed for power, recognition, and riches that never satisfies. The littleness. The wonder of that small child. This is the message of Christmas.

Introductory Rites

A lay leader (father or mother perhaps) greets those present in the following words:

Let us glorify Christ our light, who brings salvation and peace into our midst, now and for ever.

R). Amen

In the following words, the lay leader prepares those present for the blessing.

My brothers and sisters, amidst signs and wonders Christ Jesus was born in Bethlehem of Judea: His birth brings joy to our hearts and enlightenment to our minds. With this tree, decorated and adorned, may we welcome Christ among us; may its lights guide us to the perfect light.

The lay leader says the prayer with hands joined.

Lord our God,
we praise you for the light of creation:
the sun, the moon, and the stars of the night.
We praise you for the light of Israel:
the Law, the prophets, and the wisdom of the Scriptures. We praise you for Jesus Christ, your Son:
He is Emmanuel, God-with-us, the Prince of Peace,
who fills us with the wonder of your love.

Lord God,
let your blessing come upon us
as we illumine this tree.
May the light and cheer it gives
be a sign of the joy that fills our hearts.
May all who delight in this tree
come to the knowledge and joy of salvation.

We ask this through Christ our Lord.

R). Amen

The candles or lights of the tree are then illuminated.

During the illumination of the tree, the lay leader leads the family in saying

Lord Jesus, Son of God and Son of Mary.
R). We welcome you, O Lord.
Lord Jesus, hope of the shepherds and the poor.
R). We welcome you, O Lord
Lord Jesus, glory of the angels.
R). We welcome you, O Lord

Concluding Rite

The lay leader concludes the rite by signing himself or herself with the sign of the cross and saying:

May the God of glory fill our hearts with peace and joy,
now and for ever.

R). Amen

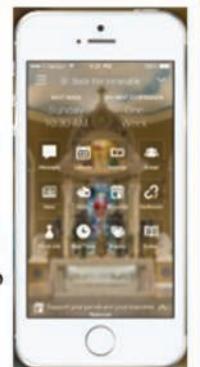
