Anointing of the Sick - In case of serious illness (or advanced age), please call the priests.

A MESSAGE FROM YOUR PASTOR

My dear parishioners,

As I write this column, it is the morning after our annual **Advent Gift Giving Mass**, and I want you to know that I am filled with gratitude and a tinge of fatherly pride. The reason is the tremendous number of wrapped Christmas presents you, our parishioners, brought for the Hispanic community of

St. Patrick's in Norristown.

Those in attendance, and many who helped with the loading of a large panel truck that transported the gifts to St. Patrick's agreed it was the largest amount of gifts ever. Fr. Manny Flores the new pastor in his homily mentioned that the Hispanic Catholic parents who will receive the gifts are so appreciative when they come to receive them at his rectory. The reason is that the money they receive from working at landscaping or construction jobs is enough for them to survive and to send some funds back to their families in Mexico, who live in poverty.

Living here in America, they feel saddened that they cannot provide the Christmas presents they would like for their children. Our donations however have made that possible. Advent indeed calls us to open our hearts to receive Jesus, and His needy brothers and sisters.

But Advent also is a call to personal repentance. In today's Gospel, St. John the Baptist challenges us to make an exodus from the desert of sinfulness through the waters of repentance to conversion of heart. It's a journey of hope – not only of past regrets. John challenges us to "Prepare the way of the Lord," by soothing treacherous bumps of sin and straightening out whatever are the

obstacles in our relationship with God and one another.

I encourage you as I would do myself to make a thorough Examination of Conscience in preparation for a good reception of the Sacrament of Reconciliation this Advent. If you don't write it down on your calendar, it won't happen!

Is it hatred for someone who has hurt you - that you have not forgiven in your heart? Have you become addicted to following everyone's life on Facebook that you don't have time to thank God for our family, as imperfect as it may be? Are political divisions making you become an angry person who has lost compassion for someone who is suffering? Personal sin has a way of damaging our heart not only physically, but spiritually as well.

While these days are filled with finding the perfect tree or the perfect gift, let it also be a time to meet the Lord, heart to heart, and allow him to enter and bring us the true peace of Christmas.

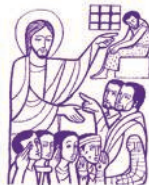
