Marriage - Saturday weddings are 10:00AM, 12:00 Noon, & 2:00 PM. It is Diocesan policy that arrangements must be made AT LEAST 6 MONTHS prior to the wedding. Information on Marriage Instructions can be obtained from the priests. For information on music, call Susan DiFlorio at 215-891-0869.

Anointing of the Sick - In case of serious illness (or advanced age), please call the priests.

Hospital cases should contact the Chaplain, but the Parish Office should be notified so one of the priests may visit the patient.







Hello Everyone

Happy New Year!!

May the Holy Family fill your homes with love, joy and peace this year! Friday was the feast of the Holy Family. While reflecting on a beautiful image of the Holy Family; Jesus, Mary and Joseph, I am reminded that their family was not perfect, dare I say it was a bit chaotic, complex and difficult. *Chaotic* in that after Jesus' birth they had to change course or change the plan and head to Egypt to protect the Child Jesus from being killed. Most of us are not escaping from a blood-thirsty king but I imagine there are many of us wanting to escape the chaotic work environments and other areas of chaos around us on a daily basis. Find comfort in knowing that the Holy Family is with you through that chaos.

Secondly, the Holy Family knows about when things become *Complex*. Traveling when pregnant and not having anywhere to rest sounds complex (and stressful) to me. This complex beginning to life here on earth does not seem fitting for this little one who is the savior of the world, yet this is the reality of his birth. Having to make a complex situation work is what parents do (I imagine Mary making a uncomfortable area comfortable for her child). Complex situations are handled by mothers—and fathers every day. Parents, just know that the Holy Family is with you through all the complexities of life.

Lastly, the Holy Family knew *difficult* times too. I imagine the community whispering behind their backs and snickering when they walked passed. I imagine those who may have saw Mary's growing belly, wondering what happened (thank God there was no such thing as Social Media back then). I even imagine those who later in life would want to throw Jesus out of his hometown (I imagine they would have thrown Mary out also), this mob scene happened when Jesus began revealing himself as the Messiah. The Holy Family definitely knows difficulties and they journey with you through your difficulties in life. Jesus, Mary and Joseph Pray for US!!

Thinking of all these aspects of family life reminded me to tell you that we are having our second **Family of Faith Gathering (for Parents) on Wed, January 25th at 7pm in the cafeteria.** This night will be different than the last one, at the last one we heard about the culture that our youth are encountering every day. The Culture Project bowled us over with statistics and stories which emphasized the need to stay aware, vigilant and prayerful as we parent in this culture. The next session will consist of a panel of parents who have children that are young adults. These parents will share some of their tips, strategies and pitfalls they encountered while raising their families. We are by no means saying theirs is the only way to parent, we believe there are nuggets of wisdom out there and we wanted to foster an atmosphere where parents can come together to hear and discuss the joys, frustrations and concerns of parenting in today's culture. **I hope to see ALL of you on the 25th!**


