**Anointing of the Sick** - In case of serious illness (or advanced age), please call the priests.

Hospital cases should contact the Chaplain, but the Parish Office should be notified so one of the priests may visit the patient.



## A MESSAGE FROM YOUR PASTOR

My dear parishioners,

More than likely I've said it before, but it is worth saying again. Thank you for your generosity the whole year through, but especially at Christmas. I am deeply conscious that inflation has caused everything we purchase to become costlier. That is why your generous stewardship of time, talent and treasure,

especially at the end of the year, is very much appreciated. It was more importantly a thrill to see that the attendance at our Christmas Masses was back to pre-COVID levels.

I also want to thank you for your patience and understanding with the recent problems you may have experienced with your church collection envelopes. The company which we have used for years recently subletted the envelope part of their business to another company. The new company does not seem capable to handle the transition to meet our needs.

After discussing the situation with many other pastors, I've decided to do what they are doing and switch our business to the company Our Sunday Visitor. Your February envelopes will still come from the former company. The March packet will be from our Our Sunday Visitor. More on this topic will come in a future bulletin column.

On a more spiritual note, take a look at that picture on page 5 of today's bulletin of the six mostly young adults and one teenager who are participating in the RCIA and who are on the journey to become Catholics. Last Sunday after four months of classes each Thursday, they were

officially enrolled as either Catechumens to receive Baptism, Confirmation and the Eucharist at the Easter Vigil, or Candidates who have already been baptized and will in the Easter season, proceed to Full Initiation into the Catholic Church. Their classes will continue for the next couple of months. We congratulate them and welcome them!

I also feel this is an important sign of a vibrant parish when we have people who want to join us in our faith. Faith is usually caught by witnessing the faith of others and how it effects their lives. We should be encouraged in our efforts to continue to be good missionary disciples of Jesus Christ. It is working.

Now that we have begun to take down our Christmas decorations I'd like to leave you with this poem, so appropriate for the New Year. It's composed by Howard Thurman, an African-American theologian, educator and civil rights leader. I share it with you each year, and it goes like this:

*When the song of the angels is stilled,  
When the star in the sky is gone,  
When the kings and princes are home,  
When the shepherds are back with their flocks,  
The work of Christmas begins:  
To find the lost. To heal the broken.  
To feed the hungry. To release the prisoners.  
To rebuild the nations. To bring peace among the people.  
And to make music in the heart.*




