Anointing of the Sick - In case of serious illness (or advanced age), please call the priests.

A MESSAGE FROM YOUR PASTOR

My dear parishioners,

As I promised in my column a few weeks ago, I'm writing today to give you more information about the change we made with our monthly mailed church collection envelopes. While many parishioners have changed their method of contributing financially to the parish through electronic giving, nonetheless

there is a significant percentage of people who still like to use the traditional paper envelopes.

Starting with your March mailing of church envelopes, you will be receiving them from a company called Our Sunday Visitor. Many other parishes in the area have made the same change. I mention this at the outset because if you are like me, when I look through my mail I'm eager to discard what I call "third-class advertisements and junk mail." So be careful! The new envelope packet may look somewhat different from what you are accustomed to.

Secondly, I hope you will like the attractive format design for the various envelope. For one thing they will be more colorful artistically, and often be printed with pictures and seasonal messages. **Our weekly envelopes will be easy to find – they will have a photo of our church on the cover - see below (The only time that will change is for special Sundays such as Palm Sunday, Pentecost, and Holy Days of Obligation).**



Any kind of change takes some time getting used to, but I hope this change will not disturb you too much. When I saw the colorful envelope samples the new company sent us as part of our negotiations, I figured that it would cost much more than our previous distributor. But amazingly, the cost is about the same to the parish.

Born in a village in Sudan, kidnapped by slavers, often beaten and abused, and later sold to Federico Marin, a Venetian merchant, Bakhita then came to Italy and became the nanny servant of Federico's daughter, Aurora, who had lost her mother at birth. Bakhita gradually comes closer to God and requests to join the order of Canossian sisters, but Marin doesn't want to give her up as his servant, treating her almost as his property. This led to a moving court case that raised an uproar, impacting Bakhita's freedom and ultimate decision to become a nun. Pope John Paul II declared her a saint in the year 2000. St. Josephine Bakhita's feast day is Feb. 11.

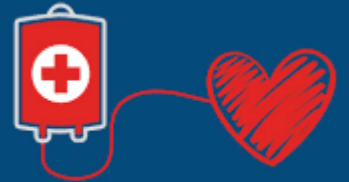

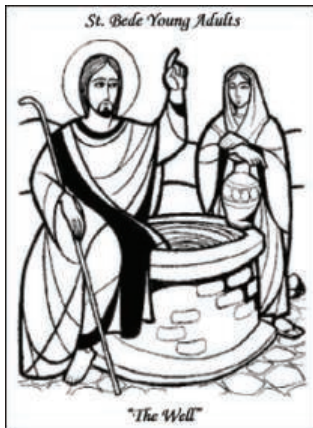
