A MESSAGE FROM YOUR PASTOR

My dear parishioners,

You have been hearing me mention on a few occasions about our new **Families of Faith Initiative**. I have written about it, spoken of it at Mass and you have probably seen either the posters in church or as full-page ads in the bulletin. So what is it all about and why should you consider attending?

This initiated with our parish staff and myself out of a concern that we have been hearing and experiencing from parents and grandparents about the loss of their children and grandchildren from the practice of their Catholic faith. As we all know the culture is changing rapidly. Before, we used to be worried about our children losing their faith in college. Now the pressures have descended into high school and younger through social media, and cultural movements that are in opposition to our Catholic beliefs about human sexuality, gender, respect for human life, etc.

Seeing this all unfold so rapidly and sensing the helplessness many parents and grandparents experience, our pastoral team felt called to provide a forum where mutual support and advice can be provided. I firmly believe, after over 45 years of being a priest, that when you bring people together in a proper, prayerful forum, the Holy Spirit guides us and empowers us.

This coming Wednesday evening at 7:00pm, we have our second session of Families of Faith. This session will be conducted by four couples from our parish who are willing to share their experiences. What have they learned so far, that they can share with other parents regarding what to do or what not to do, in keeping them connected



to our faith. We have asked them to share how they helped their children make moral decisions. How did they foster and strengthen their own personal relationship with God, in the midst of all this, and how do they model it for their children? Finally, how can parents today find hope?

After the couples speak we will take a break for some light refreshments, and give an opportunity for participants to write down some questions for the panel. Childcare will be provided by Maritza, our Youth Minister and some of her teen volunteer aides.

The meeting will be in the cafeteria, and is designed for adult listeners and participants. I hope you will find time to come. It really is important. God bless you and all of our efforts to keep our children close to the Lord.

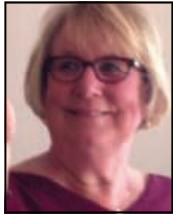

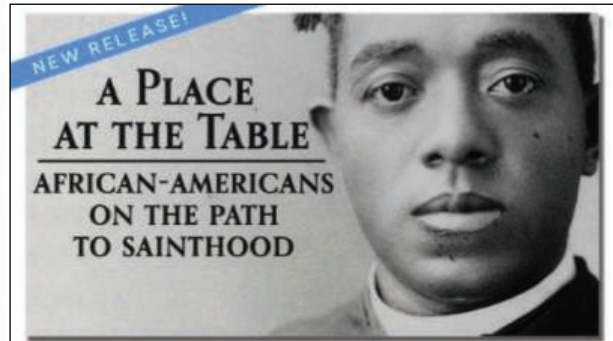

There are no African-American Saints formally recognized within the Catholic Church, but that could soon change. There are six incredible black men and women who are on the path to Canonization. The Catholic Church is starting to recognize their impact and may soon name any or all of them Saints. It's time to hear their stories.

Venerable Pierre Toussaint

Born enslaved, Toussaint gained success as a hairdresser and used his resources to serve the poor.

Servant of God Mother Mary Lange

Lange was the founder of the Oblate Sisters of Providence and the first African-American superior of any religious order.

Venerable Henriette Delille

Legally unable to join a religious order because of her African heritage, Delille started the Sisters of the Holy Family, an order that still ministers to people today.

Venerable Fr. Augustus Tolton

Tolton escaped slavery and traveled to Rome to become ordained. He was the first African-American priest in the United States.

Servant of God Julia Greeley

Greeley was an enslaved woman who became free, converted to Catholicism, and consecrated her life to the Sacred Heart of Jesus.

Servant of God Sr. Thea Bowman

Bowman converted to Catholicism as a child, became a nun, and spent her life singing, teaching, and preaching to promote devotion to Christ.

Jesus is eagerly waiting for all of us in the Eucharist to encounter us as well. This is especially poignant since the three-year Eucharistic Revival started in the Archdiocese and the United States on Corpus Christi, June 19, 2022. Please consider joining along with the Archdiocese in prayer for the success of the Eucharistic Revival. Here is the official prayer:

My God, I believe, I adore, I hope and I love You! I beg pardon for those who do not believe, nor adore, nor hope, nor love You. (Three times) Most Holy Trinity, Father, Son and Holy Spirit, I adore You profoundly. I offer You the most precious Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of Jesus Christ, present in all the tabernacles of the world in reparation for the outrages, sacrileges and indifference by which He is offended. And, through the infinite merits of the Sacred Heart of Jesus and the Immaculate Heart of Mary, I beg of You the conversion of sinners. Our Lady of Fatima, pray for us. Story of Our Lady: Our Lady of Sorrows



When Jesus was born and taken to the Temple, Simeon prophesied that Mary's heart would be pierced by a sword and the thoughts of many hearts would be revealed. (Luke: 2:34-35). This prophecy came to pass at the foot of the Cross, when our Lady stayed with Jesus to the very end and she endured a great suffering to lose her only son. Traditionally, the devotion of Our Lady of Sorrows started from the beginning of the early Church but the practice of meditating on Our Lady's sorrows did not become a popular devotion until the

13th Century. Today, the devotion consists of meditating on the seven sorrows of Mary:

1) The prophecy of Simeon (Luke 2:25-35); 2) The flight into Egypt (Matthew 2:13-15); 3) Loss of the Child Jesus for three days (Luke 2:41-50); 4) Mary meets Jesus on his way to Calvary (Luke 23:27-31; John 19:17); 5) Crucifixion and Death of Jesus (John 19:25-30); 6) The body of Jesus being taken from the Cross (Psalm 130; Luke 23:50-54; John 19:31-3; and 7) The burial of Jesus (Isaiah 53:8; Luke 23:50-56; John 19:38-42; Mark 15:40-47).

Typically, an Our Father, Hail Mary and Glory Be are prayed with each sorrow. It is a great way to walk with Jesus through the suffering of his Mother Mary and the wonderful assurance that Mary will help us if we ask her because she, like Jesus, knows what it is to suffer.

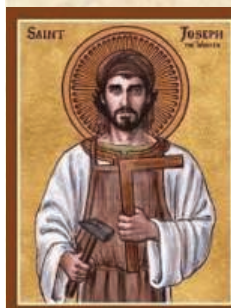
