## A MESSAGE FROM YOUR PASTOR

My dear parishioners,

Today, throughout our nation, we celebrate the beginning of **Catholic Schools Week**, with the theme and logo you see here, "**Catholic Schools: Faith, Excellence, Service.**"

The concept of parish Catholic schools, as you know, originated here in Philadelphia through the pastoral wisdom and foresight of St. John Neumann, the fourth bishop of Philadelphia. Bishop Neumann wanted to accomplish two goals by having a school in every parish: insure that young Catholics would not only have the academic credentials to succeed in life, but most importantly, an education and formation in the Catholic faith at a time when anti-Catholicism was rampant.

Today that goal in many ways is just as relevant. The culture has changed so rapidly within the last 20 years from Judeo-Christian to one that is secular and often filled with political extremes. Faith, Excellence, and Service are the reasons why we as a parish personally support and sponsor St. Katharine Drexel Regional Catholic School.

I'm happy to report that enrollment at SKD has reached its highest since I arrived here in 2005. We now have 450 students from pre-kindergarten through 8<sup>th</sup> grade. The vast majority of these students are from St. Bede Parish, with a significant percentage from Assumption BVM of Feasterville, and other parishes. Assumption BVM and St. Bede are co-sponsoring parishes.

How refreshing and comfortable it is to be able to share and discuss our Catholic faith, to respond to questions and pray as Christians do, unapologetically and freely, at St. Katharine Drexel School! It is true that our students will eventually be entering a world where people



will have very different ideals and beliefs. But how important it is for them to have a firm foundation in Jesus Christ, for He is the Way, the Truth, and the Life, in order to navigate their way through a secularized world that has no need for God

While parents are the primary teachers of their children in the ways of faith, as evidence by our near capacity enrollment, many parents are willing to make sacrifices to send their children to our school because they believe their children need that formation beyond the home, even during their school day, and with their peers. And oh yes, let me not forget to mention that **NO ONE** is denied enrollment because of financial difficulties. Please inquire about our Financial Assistance Program, funded by the **Anne Flanagan Foundation**.

As you can see, I am proud of our nationally recognized Blue Ribbon School of Excellence. I invite all of our parishioners to visit SKD during our Open House this weekend. You can also schedule your own tour as well by simply calling the school (215-357-4720). Since you help to support the school with your generosity, you are always welcome to come and see what your generosity has reaped.

### Scripture Readings

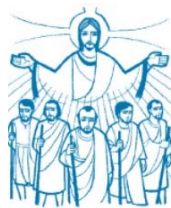
Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time

This is a phenomenal conference attended by youth from around the country. We are attending July 14-16 at Franciscan Univ. in Steubenville, Ohio. The Second experience is for youth who are H.S. Juniors or Seniors, they are invited to the Kairos retreat. Kairos is a phenomenal retreat experience, based on the Spiritual Exercises of St. Ignatius of Loyola. Youth will experience the Love of Christ like never before. These two experiences are very different yet each gives young men and women an encounter with Christ they will never forget.
