A MESSAGE FROM YOUR PASTOR

My dear parishioners,

Throughout the course of our lives, we wrestle with our identities. As children, we discover our need for friendship and learning and laughter. Sometimes these insights emerge slowly, often hard-won on the playground or the classroom or in our homes. In our teen years and into early adulthood, we begin

to identify our hungers and thirsts, and discover ways to quench them, some of which are healthy and some of which are not.

Even into mature adulthood, we sometimes find ourselves wondering who we are at the deepest levels. Are we more than our occupations? Are we still hoping for some way to leave a mark on the world? Struggling for recognition? For inner peace? Restlessness seems to be part and parcel of our human condition.

It is this restlessness, this unsteady-ness that the devil wants to exploit, if he can, in the encounter with Jesus in the desert, in this Sunday’s Gospel. In this desert experience, the devil is trying to tempt Jesus to forget His identity as Son of God.

It would be easy enough for us to simply say that Jesus was divine, so the devil’s tricks would never have worked. But Sacred Scripture is very clear that Jesus entered fully into the human condition. And that means He would have experienced these temptations as true temptations - things that would have been attractive on some level.

The devil entered the scene after Jesus’ lengthy fast, and makes proposals that might have lured Jesus to choose an easier way to achieve His mission. And isn’t that the way with us? When we’re in a weakened state, maybe stripped of strength during a long battle with illness or mourning the tragic death of a loved one or divorce, we can experience a vulnerability to temptation that is easily exploited. But it can also happen when everything is going right and we are easily fooled into a false sense of security.

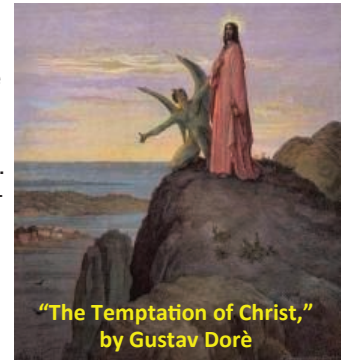
The story of Jesus and the devil reminds us that only God’s promises of security are worth the price. In that story, the devil tried to plant doubts in the mind and heart of Jesus. But Jesus knew who He was – the Son of God.

This Gospel is a perfect beginning for our observance of Lent. Too often, unlike Jesus, we have been lured into a false sense of security that makes us feel like we don’t need God. “I can do it alone,” or “It might be better to choose an easier way than what God seems to be calling me to.” In our bad choices, we reveal that we have forgotten who we are, that we are children of God by Baptism.


The Sacrament of Reconciliation, a good confession, is the pathway back to rediscover that identity and to allow Jesus to “re-boot” our life. This Lent there are many opportunities to encounter Jesus this way. There is an Archdiocesan-wide **Reconciliation Weekend** for one, where all the priests of the Archdiocese have been asked to combine their efforts at two parishes on the weekend of **March 10 & 11**, on a Friday evening and a Saturday afternoon. On Friday it will be from 3:00pm to 8:00pm, and on Saturday from 9:30am to 11:30am. Look at page 3 of this bulletin for further details. Jesus and your restless heart is waiting.

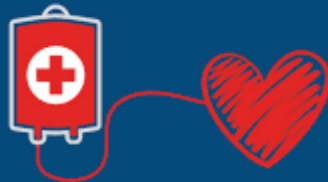

Story of Our Lady: Our Lady of La Salette:

In 1846 on the 19th of September in a small little village in France, Our Lady appeared to two children in tears. She called the children to her with the following words: "Come near, my children, be not afraid. I am here to tell you great news."



She spoke to the two children, Melanie and Maximin, about the reason for her grief. She spoke to them that she was suffering for the world to hold back the just hands of God. Our Lady spoke of the things

that were causing her great pain in suffering: 1) Catholics working on Sunday and not keeping the Sabbath Holy, 2) Using the Lord's name in vain, 3) Not going to Sunday Mass in the summertime, and 4) eating meat on the fast days during Lent.

Not only did Our Lady of La Salette bring a stark warning to the people of that day but she also called them to conversion, to return to Christ in love with prayer, sacrifice and communion.

Our Lady of La Salette pray for us so we can return to your Son with love and joy in our lives this Lent.
