A MESSAGE FROM YOUR PASTOR

My dear parishioners,

One of the beautiful and helpful aspects of the Lenten season is the many amazing opportunities for spiritual re-awakening and renewal that are offered both in our parish and in the broader community. Sometimes we think that Lent is merely about us going out to seek and find God on a deeper level. But

we must remember that at the same time, if not even more so, it is God in Christ Jesus who is seeking US this Lent.

Perhaps the events (or better said, “encounters”) with Jesus that I am writing about today in this column are precisely ways that God is seeking you and me. The first event is **Reconciliation Weekend**, which is being celebrated throughout the Archdiocese next weekend, March 10 and 11.



Within every grouping of parishes in the Archdiocese called “deaneries,” there are two parishes that have been chosen to host this weekend when for several hours, priests of that area are joining forces to provide the faithful

several opportunities for Confession.

In our deanery (of which I am the Dean), the two parishes chosen are **Our Lady of Good Counsel in Southampton, and St. Jude in Chalfont**. At Our Lady of Good Counsel, confessions will be heard continuously on Friday, March 10 from 3:00pm to 8:00pm, then on Saturday March 11 from 8:30am to 11:30am.

At St. Jude in Chalfont, confessions will be heard on Friday March 10 from 3:00pm to 8:00pm, then on Saturday March 11 from 9:30am to 11:30am. The point is this: sometimes a person feels more comfortable going to a parish where they are unknown. Also, if it's been many years, don't let that stop you. All priests are ready to guide you to unburden your heart.

The other encounter where Jesus may be wanting to meet you is at our annual **Parish Mission**, which begins next Sunday March 12 and concludes Tuesday March 14. We welcome **Fr. Dominic Bump**, a Dominican priest stationed currently at St. Patrick Parish on Rittenhouse Square in Philly, to lead our mission. Fr. Bump is an artist, and he will be using the imagery of icons and the writings of saints to lead us through the theme: “*How to Live a Life of Grace this Lent.*” In fact, we will hear him preach at all of our Masses next weekend.

God is like a friend who loves to walk the journey of life with us. And like a good friend, God keeps calling to, “Set up a time when you and I can reconnect.” Like every good friendship, but infinitely greater, every encounter with Jesus makes us a better person. In fact, more like Him.

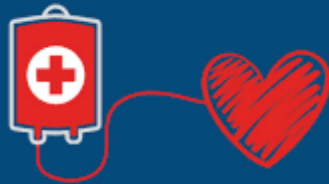

Collection for Church in Latin America March 11-12

Dear sisters and brothers in Christ,

Soon our Archdiocese will take up the Annual Collection for the Church in Latin America. For more than 50 years, this collection has been a way for Catholics in the United States to unite more closely with our brothers and sisters in faith throughout Latin America and the Caribbean. Funds generated from this initiative support diocesan pastoral, catechetical and family life ministries, seminary studies, and formation

programs for religious sisters and brothers. This collection also helps the poorest dioceses obtain basic necessities that they would not be unable to afford otherwise. Without your help they would not be able to meet the pastoral and temporal needs of those who count on them.

At the far eastern end of the island of Cuba, the priests in the Diocese of Guantimamo-Baracoa traverse bad roads over rough terrain to bring the sacraments and the Word of God to the faithful living in that remote region. The mountainous territory that makes up 75% of the diocese's total land area makes travel not only difficult but also more expensive for priests due to higher fuel consumption, vehicle maintenance, and repair costs when compared to other regions.

Catholics like you who generously contribute to the Collection for the Church in Latin America help Guantanamo-Baracoa's priests stay on the road with funds given to the diocese to offset fuel and vehicle repair costs. In places such as Cuba, you help bring the Good News to the poor when you participate in the collection.

Our Archdiocese will take up this Collection the weekend of March 11 and 12, 2023. Please be generous and take this opportunity to share your faith with the families of Latin America and the Caribbean. Your support will truly make a difference. Thank you and God bless you.

Archbishop grants dispensation from abstaining from meat on St. Patrick's Day

Archbishop Nelson J. Pérez, in accord with the *Code of Canon Law* (canon 87), has granted a dispensation to all Roman Catholics in the Archdiocese of Philadelphia from the obligation to abstain from meat on the Memorial of Saint Patrick - Friday, March 17, 2023.



The United States Catholic Bishops prescribe as a *minimal obligation* that all persons who are fourteen years of age and older are bound to abstain from eating meat on the Fridays of Lent. This is a corporate gesture of penance observed by all the members of the Church in the United States.

In certain circumstances, such as the coincidence of Saint Patrick's Day and a Friday of Lent, the Diocesan Bishop may grant a dispensation from this obligation. However, as with every Friday of the Church Year outside of Lent, if a Catholic makes the choice not to abstain from meat, then some other penance of choice is to be observed in honor of the passion and death of our Lord on the cross.

On Saint Patrick's Day, the memory of this missionary Apostle to Ireland recalls his preaching of the Faith; and his encouragement to live authentic Christian lives. Lent does not disappear with the festive celebration of St. Patrick. Rather, in the Archdiocese of Philadelphia, Roman Catholics may fittingly observe March 17, 2023 with another choice of penance rather than abstaining from meat.
