Anointing of the Sick - In case of serious illness (or advanced age), please call the priests.

My dear parishioners,

It has been a week now since Easter Sunday, which climaxed a deeply profound, beautiful and well attended celebration of Holy Week here at St. Bede. On behalf of Father Ryan, I want to thank all the many parishioners and staff who had any large or small part in making sure that each celebration of our Lord's Passion, Death and Resurrection were celebrated with dignity, respect, and meaning.

That only happens when people really care. And you, the people of St. Bede Parish do care. Whether you prepared the music, the decorations, usher people to their seats, or simply showed up, you helped to create the setting, or for want of a better word the atmosphere for all of us to encounter Jesus anew in a fresh, meaningful way.

Like many of you, I have attended or participated in many Holy Week Liturgies throughout my life. But every year, amidst so much that is the same or traditional, there is always something that is different. What is different is usually us, you and me. Did you ever notice that our crosses, our concerns, our worries, or our joys seem to be somehow different each year as we grow older?

But how important it is for us to realize that through his Son Jesus, God has experienced everything we go through in life. God, as they say, "walked the walk." So He can "talk the talk."

And what God talks about in this weekend's Mass on Divine Mercy Sunday is He invited Thomas through Jesus his Son to touch His nail marks, and His wounded side. By touching our own woundedness, and that of others, we are comforted in knowing that Jesus knows what suffering is. For even now in heaven, He bears the marks of His Passion.

But more importantly, we must take from this weekend's Gospel the testimony of "**Doubting Thomas.**" For Thomas proves to all of us that Jesus is risen beyond our doubts. And He is the Lord of all history. When we look at our world today with all of its craziness and danger, let us recall Thomas. He faced a world very much like ours. But by seeing and touching Jesus, he went out and boldly faced a hostile world. And died proclaiming Jesus, risen and Lord and God. And because of people like Thomas, we are here, 2,000 years later.

And so it is my hope and prayer that having encountered the risen Jesus in our many beautiful liturgies here at St. Bede, we may, with renewed hope like Thomas, bring that Good News to all we meet. And do our little part to change this world.

Dear parishioners,

Happy Easter! Christ is risen! Happy Divine Mercy Sunday! May God bless us all to be wonderful instruments of mercy in word, prayer and action! Enjoy your last day of the Easter Octave and continue the joy through the entire Easter Season. The Church celebrates the Easter season (also known as “Easter tide”) for 50 days, culminating with the feast of Pentecost, where Scripture tells us that the Holy Spirit descended on the Apostles (Acts 2:1-31). Pentecost falls on Sunday May 28th. The Ascension of the Lord, a holy day of obligation, falls on Thursday May 18th. Christ's Ascension marks the definitive entrance of Jesus' humanity into God's heavenly domain, whence he will come again (cf. Acts 1:11); this humanity in the meantime hides him from the eyes of men (cf. Col 3:3). Or in the words of the Catechism: “Jesus Christ, the head of the Church, precedes us into the Father's glorious kingdom so that we, the members of his Body, may live in the hope of one day being with him forever. Jesus Christ, having entered the sanctuary of heaven once and for all, intercedes constantly for us as the mediator who assures us of the permanent outpouring of the Holy Spirit.” (CCC: 665-667). This is our Easter Hope!
