# Palm Sunday of the Lord's Passion April 2, 2023

*Hosanna to the Son of David; blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord.*  
(Matthew 2: 9)



## A MESSAGE FROM YOUR PASTOR

My dear parishioners,

Welcome to the holiest week of the year! We hear in today's liturgy of Palm Sunday that as Jesus entered Jerusalem, just four short days before He would be arrested, He was received with great joy. As He entered, riding a donkey, the crowd spread their cloaks, strew palm branches before Him, and cried out, "Hosanna to the Son of David! Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord!" He was given a kingly welcome.

Jerusalem itself was the place of the temple where so many of the ancient kings of Israel offered sacrifice to God. For centuries each year, the high priest entered the Holy of Holies to offer a sacrifice to God. However, little did anyone know that, as Jesus entered Jerusalem, the entire city became the New Temple, and Jesus became the final and definitive Priest that day.

He entered this new holy of holies as a king and priest, and He died as the sacrificial lamb. He was greeted with shouts of Hosanna, only to soon hear, "Crucify Him! Crucify Him!" How could this be? How could something so glorious become so painful in such a short amount of time? From an earthly perspective, what would soon follow made no sense. But from a divine perspective, it was the beginning of the most glorious act ever known.

The evil one certainly watched in hatred and jealousy as Jesus, on Palm Sunday, was given this glorious reception. The envy of the evil one was so great that it became alive in the souls of some of the religious leaders, and the betrayal of Judas, the cruel action of the civil authorities, and the confused emotions of the crowds who gathered for the Passover celebration. Who could have known that on that Passover, the lamb of sacrifice would be Jesus - God in the Flesh?

In our own lives, we often do all we can to avoid even the slightest amount of sacrifice. But sacrifice is capable of the greatest good, when united to the one sacrifice of Jesus. You see, in a mysterious way, Jesus invites us to the cross, to complete His work of the redemption of the world. If we unite our suffering to the cross of Jesus, then we can be certain that our suffering will be transformed by the power of this Holy Week and lead to our sharing of His triumph over sin, suffering and death.

That is why I say every year that this coming week should not be "business as usual" for any of us, if at all possible. So I encourage you to come to the services of Holy Thursday, Good Friday, Holy Saturday, and of course, Easter Sunday.

The sacrifice you make to come will be rewarded with a renewed understanding of how Holy Week permeates every aspect of your life and mine, so that as we die with Christ, we will also share in His resurrection.

May God bless you.

## Chrism Mass at the Cathedral

The annual Chrism Mass will be held at the Cathedral Basilica of Saints Peter and Paul on **Holy Thursday, April 6 at 10 a.m.**, with the procession starting at 9:40 a.m. The Chrism Mass is the Liturgy celebrated each year by the Archbishop and concelebrated by all the priests of the Archdiocese. It is a day on which priests make a recommitment of their priesthood and the Archbishop blesses the holy oils that will be used for the sacraments in each parish (Including the Holy Chrism, Oil of the Catechumens, and the Oil of the Sick). The public is invited to this very meaningful and impressive Liturgy.



## Adoration Society

**H**oly Week starts with Palm Sunday, which is the most solemn period of worship in the Christian faith. This week starts with joy and celebrates Jesus' entry into Jerusalem. This is a perfect time to join in adoration, as we follow the events from this point through His way to Calvary.

# EXAMINATION OF CONSCIENCE

## **1. I AM THE LORD YOUR GOD. YOU SHALL NOT HAVE STRANGE GODS BEFORE ME.**

Do I give God time every day in prayer?  
Do I seek to love Him with my whole heart?  
Have I been involved in witchcraft, superstition or black magic?  
Have I received Communion in a state of mortal sin?  
Have I deliberately told a lie in Confession or withheld a mortal sin in Confession?

## **2. YOU SHALL NOT TAKE THE NAME OF THE LORD YOUR GOD IN VAIN.**

Did I curse or swear? Did I use God's name in vain, lightly, carelessly, by blasphemy?  
Have I wished evil upon another person?  
Have I been angry with God and stayed in that state of anger?  
Have I insulted a sacred person or abused a sacred object?

## **3. REMEMBER TO KEEP HOLY THE LORD'S DAY.**

Have I deliberately missed Mass on Sundays or Holy Days of obligation?  
Have I tried to observe Sunday as a family day and a day of rest?  
Do I get enough rest or am I constantly running?  
Do I do needless work on Sunday?

## **4. HONOR YOUR FATHER AND YOUR MOTHER.**

Do I honor and obey my parents? Am I respectful towards them?  
Have I neglected my duties to my spouse and children?  
Have I given my family good religious example and try to bring peace into the home?  
Do I care for my aged and infirmed relatives?

## **5. YOU SHALL NOT KILL.**

Have I had an abortion or encouraged anyone to have an abortion?  
Have I mutilated myself through any form of sterilization, etc.?  
Have I harbored anger or resentment or hatred in my heart?  
Have I physically harmed anyone? Have I driven recklessly (too fast, showing off, etc.)?  
Have I abused alcohol or drugs?  
Have I hurt myself through cutting, scratching, or in any other way?

## **6. YOU SHALL NOT COMMIT ADULTERY.**

Have I been faithful to my marriage vows in thought and action?  
Have I engaged in any sexual activity outside of marriage (intercourse, oral sex, inappropriate touching, mutual masturbation)?  
Has each sexual act in my marriage been open to the transmission of new life?  
Have I been guilty of masturbation? Have I entertained lustful thoughts?  
Have I been guilty of any homosexual activity?  
Do I seek to be chaste in my thoughts, words, and actions?  
Was I "immodest" in the way I dressed, acted or spoke (leading others to arousal)?  
Are my words, texts and photos on Facebook and/or other social media sites sexually charged?  
Did I look at pornography or visit chat rooms that were inappropriate?

## **7. YOU SHALL NOT STEAL.**

Have I stolen what is not mine?  
Have I returned or made restitution for what I have stolen?  
Did I waste time at work (which is really stealing from the company)?  
Do I gamble excessively, thereby denying my family of their needs?  
Do I seek to share what I have with the poor?

## **8. YOU SHALL NOT BEAR FALSE WITNESS AGAINST YOUR NEIGHBOR.**

Have I lied? Have I gossiped? Have I spoken behind someone else's back?  
Do I always tell the truth? Did I reveal secrets that should have been kept confidential?  
Am I sincere in my dealings with others?  
Am I critical, negative, or uncharitable in my thoughts of others?  
Is what I write in my emails, IM's, text messages or on any social media sites true about myself or others?

## **9. YOU SHALL NOT DESIRE YOUR NEIGHBOR'S WIFE.**

Have I caused impure thoughts by impure reading, movies, conversations or curiosity?  
Do I pray at once to banish impure thoughts and temptations?

## **10. YOU SHALL NOT DESIRE YOUR NEIGHBOR'S GOODS.**

Am I jealous of what other people have?  
Do I envy the families or possessions of others?  
Am I greedy or selfish?  
Are material possessions the purpose of my life?
