My dear parishioners,
Over the last few Sundays, we have paid special attention in this bulletin to pictures of the five adults who participated in the RCIA, a process which means the Rites of Christian Initiation of Adults. In fact, this week's bulletin provides pictures of the three adults (Michael Pierce, Michael Love and Brigham Breiner) who, last Sunday at the 11:00am Mass, received the Sacraments of Confirmation and First Communion, after professing their belief in the teachings of the Catholic Church.

On the Second Sunday of Easter we featured the two adults (Norsang Lama and Lori Accardi) who had never been baptized and were fully initiated in Christ's Church at the Easter Vigil through Baptism, Confirmation and First Communion. Why do we pay so much attention to them? Well, to welcome them for sure. And to share the Good News that new members are being constantly added to the Catholic Church.

But perhaps there is a more important reason, with implications for all of us. For their enthusiasm and joy serve as a signal to us of the same joy we should have each time we encounter Jesus in the Sacraments. Human nature being what it is, we who receive these Sacraments at an early age can sometimes receive them routinely, with little reflection on the awesome reality that Christ enters our life in such a special, transformative way.

These Fifty days of Easter are a significant time for new Catholics. It is referred to as "The Mystagogia," a Greek word which means "the uncovering of the mysteries." The newly baptized and the already baptized and now fully initiated Christians are encouraged during this

season to reflect on what this experience truly means, and what the implications are for their life.

But really and truly, the entire community is to spend time asking the very same questions. Those who just entered the Church remind us that we should all be attentive to the ongoing process of conversion and renewal that God wants to happen in our lives, even if we have been born a Catholic.

We need Fifty Days of Easter to teach all of us the implications of living in the shadow of the cross, and living in the mystery of the Risen Lord. Jesus' passage from death to life paved the way, opened the doors, and mirrors the passage we must all make. Death has lost its power in Jesus' Resurrection! During this Easter season, we recommit to die and rise with Christ. And guided

by His Holy Spirit, we now go out, to teach and baptize all nations, in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.

May God bless you.



Happy Eastertide! Christ is risen! These are the days of celebration and renewal as we journey towards Pentecost. Let us all continue to pray for the Church, the Eucharistic Revival and for St. Bede the Venerable parish to be a beacon of God's love and hope to our community and the whole world!

Story of Our Lady: Our Lady of Happy Meeting in Le Laus France:



In 1664, Our Lady appeared to Benoite Rencurel, a poor shepherdess. Benoite (Benedicta) was born in the southern French Alps. The Virgin Mary continued appearing to her throughout the rest of her life, she died in 1718. During the apparitions, the Blessed Mother asked for a church and a house for priests to be built, for all to pray for sinners and conversion, through the sacrament of penance. The holy site draws 120,000 pilgrims annually. Numerous physical healings have also been associated with the site, especially when oil from a lamp is applied on the wounds according to the directives the Virgin Mary gave to Rencurel. Benedicta suffered with the stigmata the last 15 years of her life.
