A MESSAGE FROM YOUR PASTOR

My dear parishioners,

Many of you know by now that there's a great amount of devotion among our parishioners to Padre Pio. In fact I have been amazed, as I go about speaking to parishioners or visiting the sick in their homes to see and hear stories of prayers answered, cures happening, or faith in Jesus restored through Padre Pio's intercession.

Parishioners have shared with me that our annual Padre Pio Festival has served to strengthen their devotion and cause them to share their devotion with others. You may be happy to know that our recent Padre Pio Festival was very successful in many ways. Many people traveled from near and far to join us for the spiritual, cultural and social benefits of the festival.

I'm happy to announce that, through the many generous sponsors and donors to last year's festival, we were not only able to defray expenses connected with it, and enjoy a modest profit for future development, but also to donate the excess profit to St. Mary Medical Center's Children's Emergency Trauma Center. Last week, a few members of the festival committee and I presented a check to Dr. Michael Magro, President of St. Mary Medical Center, and other hospital officials in the actual Children's Emergency Unit.

As you know, Padre Pio was instrumental in building a hospital in San Giovanni Rotondo, Italy for the care of poor people in that area, and especially for children. I believe that Padre Pio was very happy with our efforts that so much reflected his life.

I have mentioned to several people that I have begun pursuing the cause to have our parish designated as the Archdiocesan Shrine of Padre Pio. In order to secure that designation, we have to show the Archdiocese that there is ongoing devotion in our parish to this holy saint. This led me to consider establishing a **Padre Pio Prayer Group** here at our parish. So as not to create another new thing, I thought after consultation with our Pastoral Council to attach it to our Tuesday Night Rosary

Group, which gathers each week to pray for various intentions.

The Padre Pio Prayer Group would meet once a month, on Tuesday evening, at 7:00pm. And after praying with the present Rosary group, there would be a time for reflection on Padre Pio, and opportunity for questions and answers about our Catholic faith, etc. It would be open not only to parishioners, but to all in the area with devotion to Padre Pio.

I'm anxious to hear feedback about this idea, and look forward to your comments. Also, I invite you to the Rosary Group this Tuesday evening, May 2, where I will talk more about the Padre Pio Prayer Group. They meet in the lower chapel. I hope to see you there!

Introduction to Theology of the Body by Christopher West (Ascension Press)



St. Bede the Venerable Parish Adult Faith Formation program will offer "An Introduction to Theology of the Body: Discovering the Master Plan for Your Life" starting on **Tuesday, June 6th, 2023**. It is an 8 week program for \$40. Participants will meet in the Drexel Center Room B to view an engaging video presentation preceded by a time of lively group discussion and fellowship.

Based on Saint John Paul II's revolutionary teaching and presented by world-renowned speaker and author Christopher West, "An Introduction to the Theology of the Body: Discovering the Master Plan for Your Life", is a comprehensive system designed to lay a firm foundation for those who desire to incorporate the Theology of the Body into their daily lives. Most people have heard the "whats" of Catholic teaching, but very few have ever heard the "whys." With profound insight, Christopher West demonstrates that the Church's teaching on sex and marriage "makes sense", and, in fact, is the "logic" of Christianity, because it corresponds perfectly with the deepest stirrings and desires of the human heart.  - See how God's mystery is revealed through the body and spousal love.

The course will meet in the Drexel Center on Tuesday mornings from 9:45 to 11:15 AM and in the evenings from 7 to 8:30 PM.
