# Fifth Sunday of Easter

## May 7, 2023



*"I am the Way and the Truth and the Life. No one comes to the Father except through Me."*  
**John 14: 6**



### A MESSAGE FROM YOUR PASTOR

My dear parishioners,

*"Do not let your hearts be troubled. You have faith in God, have faith in Me, for the Father has sent Me to be the Way, the Truth, and the Life."*

In a certain and real sense, those words are Jesus' way of telling us that He needs to be our everything. And that by listening to Him and following Him and imitating Him, we will never get lost. And we will be with God for all eternity.

That's an incredibly confident pledge, and one that assures us that our faith in Him is our salvation, our hope and our life. And yet, faith in Jesus means more than just saying, "Yes God, I'd like to go to heaven someday." Rather, true faith is more than that. Being faithful also means that we believe in the potential of every human being, and their inherent dignity. The possibility for every person to be loving and kind and compassionate.

It means we believe God's beauty is present in countless places, situations and people. It means we can help make this world an even better place, and have a responsibility to do so. Being faithful means that we believe that the world is not falling apart, but rather is how it's been since the fall of Adam and Eve. Imperfect. Wounded. Broken, and in continual need of healing. Humanity's best days aren't behind us, but are, with God's grace, ahead of us, since every single person can be changed for the better.

Being faithful means believing that no problem we face has more power than God's love. And what Jesus has done for us in dying and rising has changed absolutely everything, and consequently must change the way we see the world and each other.

In other words, as followers of Jesus, as believers, it is our responsibility to not feed into negativity and cynicism and hopelessness, so rampant among us. We can't be people who constantly speak in such a "doom and gloom" kind of way. Even though we feel that way. Can we really say that we have faith? That we say we believe what we say that we believe about the risen Jesus, if we constantly speak to the contrary?

I don't mean to suggest that we are supposed to ignore the problems of the world, or pretend that they don't exist. Or speak in a phony kind of way. But being a true Christian means that we must be people of joy and hope and compassion and peace. And if people don't see that in us, then our faith has lost its power. Its ability to make a real and lasting difference in our lives. The kind of difference that changes hearts and, ultimately, changes the world.

As we read from the Acts of the Apostles during this Easter season, we learn that the first followers of Jesus faced a pagan secularized world, probably worse than what we face. If anything was hopeless, it was that world. But they faced it with hope and by letting Jesus be the Way, and the Truth, and the Life. As we look upon the Easter candle in our sanctuary during this season of hope, let it remind us that rather than cursing the darkness, let us light the candle of our faith, hope and love. And do what those early Christians did – change the world, one person at a time.

## Introduction to Theology of the Body by Christopher West (Ascension Press)



St. Bede the Venerable Parish Adult Faith Formation program will offer “An Introduction to Theology of the Body: Discovering the Master Plan for Your Life” starting on **Tuesday, June 6th, 2023**. It is an 8 week program for \$40. Participants will meet in the Drexel Center Room B to view an engaging video presentation preceded by a time of lively group discussion and fellowship.

Based on Saint John Paul II’s revolutionary teaching and presented by world-renowned speaker and author Christopher West, “An Introduction to the Theology of the Body: Discovering the Master Plan for Your Life”, is a comprehensive system designed to lay a firm foundation for those who desire to incorporate the Theology of the Body into their daily lives.
