A MESSAGE FROM YOUR PASTOR

My dear parishioners,

Today as we celebrate **Mother's Day**, I join with all of you in honoring and remembering our mothers and yes, even our grandmothers, whether they are living or deceased. It is so easy to forget how important their guidance, influence and nurturing have been for each of us.

You know, as we progress in life and add diplomas, degrees, and accomplishments to our resumés, we can easily forget that while we worked hard for that degree or that promotion, it is not on our merits alone that we received it.

Let us consider for a moment the thoughts of two great men about the role their mothers played in their lives. George Washington once said, "My mother was the most beautiful woman I ever saw. All I am I owe to my mother. I attribute all my success in life to the moral, intellectual, and physical education I received from her." Abraham Lincoln spoke in similar words when he said, "All that I am or ever hoped to be I owe to my mother."

All mothers who wish to be true to their high calling need only to look to the woman who became the greatest mother of all – Mary, the mother of Jesus. Listen to what St. John Paul II wrote in his encyclical, **Redemptoris Mater – Mother of the Redeemer**: *"It can thus be said that women, by looking to Mary, find in her the secret of loving their family with dignity, and achieving in them our truest advancement."*

John Paul II continues: *"In light of Mary, the Church sees in the face of woman the reflection of a beauty which mirrors the loftiest sentiments of which the human heart is*

capable: the self-offering, totality of love; the strength that is capable of bearing the greatest sorrows; limitless fidelity and tireless devotion to work; the ability to combine penetrating intuition with words of support and encouragement."

I cannot read these words without thinking of my own mother. I am an only child and at first my mother never wanted to hear me speak about going into the seminary. Her hope and plan was that her only son would someday marry, become a doctor or a lawyer or an executive, give her grandchildren, and make her happy. The interesting irony is that in many ways, my vocation came from the faith of my mother and father.

But like Mary had to do, my mother had to let God's plan push her own plan aside.

Perhaps Mary had hoped that her only Son Jesus, another only child, would have been like all the other children in Nazareth: eventually get married, have children and give her grandchildren. When Mary saw all the miracles her Son performed for people, she must have been so proud. Once I entered the seminary and my mother saw my happiness, it became her happiness as well. And she became my greatest support. When my mother was sick and dying, she was always surrounded not only by my caring aunts, uncles and cousins, but by the many priest friends, which had become her sons, as well. And so I say to all our mothers what I would say to my own mother in heaven: Mothers, we salute you. Mothers, we pray for you. Mothers, we love you.

May God bless you.



Happy Eastertide! Christ is risen! Happy 6th Sunday of Easter! This Sunday, the Scriptures take us to Samaria with the Apostle Philip who proclaimed the Gospel to the people who both paid attention to what he was speaking and heard it (Acts 8:5-8, 14-17). **Mr. Shawn Tobin** This is such a poignant reading because these two points are probably the two biggest things that people struggle with during Mass, paying attention and hearing what is really being said. Two great ways to improve your experience at Mass are to 1) ask your guardian angel to open your heart to truly hear the Mass and to keep you focused and 2) consider taking a small journal to Mass with you and write down one point that stands out to you during the Mass. I learned this second point from the Catholic Evangelist, Mathew Kelly. He also recommends to take 15 minutes after Mass to journal on what touched your heart and why and how it can help you to be a better Catholic the next week. It is amazing. I did it several years ago and the Mass came alive for me, not only on Sunday but alive in my heart the rest of the week.



Eucharistic Revival: Continue to keep the Eucharistic Revival in your hearts and prayers and especially for all Catholic and all people to meet Jesus in the “Breaking of the Bread.” Prayer is the foundation of change and revival. Check out the Archdiocese Website for more information:



Cornerstone for Life

Pro-Life advocates turn old Texas abortion clinic into a parenting center

Texans are steadily transforming their state into a place that supports mothers and babies from the moment of conception. Right now in McAllen, pro-life advocates are working on plans to turn a former abortion facility into a parenting center – one that will offer free parenting classes, baby supplies, post-abortion counseling and more in one of the poorest parts of the state.

“This is a huge victory for the Lord because we did nothing. He did it all,” said Yolanda Chapa, founder of the McAllen Pregnancy Center, which now owns the building.

For 40 years, the abortion facility killed unborn babies in the Rio Grande Valley, the last decade under the Whole Women’s Health abortion chain. Chapa said that she prayed outside the abortion facility for 17 years, offering hope and support to abortion-minded mothers.

“I was there in the rain, or heat — sometimes it was 105 degrees and we were there from seven in the morning until like one,” she said.

All the while, she said she and other sidewalk counselors were called nasty names and yelled at by abortion workers. Chapa said they “hated” pro-lifers.

In 2008, Chapa opened the McAllen Pregnancy Center a few doors down from the abortion facility to offer life-affirming resources, including pregnancy tests, ultrasounds, diapers, referrals to doctors and more to struggling families, according to the report. Some of the women who they serve are considering abortions, others just need help, she said.

Every day for years, Chapa said she continued to pray for an end to abortion in her community. Then, in June, God answered her prayers and those of so many others when the U.S. Supreme Court overturned *Roe v. Wade*.
