### A MESSAGE FROM YOUR PASTOR

My dear parishioners,

How can I not write about our first ever **Corpus Christi Procession**, conducted by St. Bede parish along with our two neighboring parishes, St. Vincent dePaul in Richboro and Nativity of Our Lord in Warminster? I say that because all week, even up to today (the Thursday after the Procession), people keep coming up, telling me how much this unique public event touched their hearts and renewed their faith.

If you were unable to attend, just take a look at the photos on page 3 of this bulletin, on Facebook, or click on this one-minute video on youtube, put together by our Permanent Deacon Candidate, Matt Ruel: [www.youtube.com/watch?v=H-sx33ckzcA](https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=H-sx33ckzcA). Glance at those photos and look at the outpouring of people that participated. I want to publicly thank the Chief of Northampton Police **Steve LeCompte** for suggesting Northampton Municipal Park as the site and for providing police for our protection, as well as **Debbie Catoggio** and the Parks and Recreation Office for making the beautiful park available to us.

Jesus said, *"When I am lifted up from the earth, I will draw everyone to Myself."* (John 12: 32). The Church says that it is fitting on Corpus Christi that we lift up Jesus in the Eucharist and process Him around. It is the way of showing the world what we believe about Jesus and how **He truly becomes Present to us in this Most Blessed Sacrament.**

I think this is a profound way to affect culture. When it happens people think, as joggers and walkers and children and parents on swings in the park did and asked, "What a minute – what are those Catholics doing over here? They're singing hymns of praise with a band to God and in the presence of a fancy container holding what looks like a piece of bread?" It might seem unusual, but because of what we know of Jesus' Word, *"This is My Body,"* we know it's true. And so we're proclaiming the Truth in a beautiful, reverent, joyful and most importantly a public way. Numerous people told me that night that people stopped them and asked them, "Hey, what gives?" and after the Catholic person told them what it was all about they had a look like, "Wow – that's impressive."



I had the privilege of celebrating the last Benediction of the three stations we had that night. And even though I was a bit tired, something inspired me to lift the Monstrance as high as my arms could reach as I blessed everyone with it. I really do believe it may have been those Words of Jesus, *"When I am lifted up from the earth, I will draw all people to Myself."*

In the Gospel, Jesus was not speaking of the spontaneous reaction of fear in the face of perceived danger. Not to feel that fear would be abnormal. He was referring to the fear that controls a person's deliberate response in the face of such danger. At times, it can be responsible to avoid danger. At other times, perils need to be faced and endured for the sake of a greater good. Jesus was insisting that discipleship – and the hope of eternal life – would be dangerous, but that this danger was to be faced and borne courageously.
