

Marriage - Saturday weddings are 10:00AM, 12:00 Noon, & 2:00 PM. It is Diocesan policy that arrangements must be made AT LEAST 6 MONTHS prior to the wedding. Information on Marriage Instructions can be obtained from the priests. For information on music, call Susan DiFlorio at 215-891-0869.

Anointing of the Sick - In case of serious illness (or advanced age), please call the priests.

Hospital cases should contact the Chaplain, but the Parish Office should be notified so one of the priests may visit the patient.



A MESSAGE FROM YOUR PASTOR

My dear parishioners,

Today we celebrate one of the great feast days of our faith: The Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ, also known by its Latin title: Corpus Christi. The greatest gift that Christ gave to the Church was the total gift of self in the signs or appearances of bread and wine. Truly, His Body and Blood. The Eucharist is not merely a symbol of His Body and Blood, as our Protestant brothers and sisters believe, but really and truly His Body and Blood, present for adoration, and our spiritual nourishment.

The Eucharist is the source and summit of our Christian life (Catechism of the Catholic Church). In the Eucharist we truly encounter the Lord Jesus and are plugged in to His Paschal mystery – His dying and rising. It's through this encounter that our lives are transformed. The Eucharist is not an object or a thing. The Eucharist is a Person, who is alive and who transforms our lives.

But it is not like taking a pill or an aspirin. We take a pill in our mouths and we don't have to do anything else. When I take my pills at breakfast time, I'm usually reading the newspaper or checking the news on my phone at the same time. Even if I'm not paying attention to what I'm doing, the pills still work.

The Eucharist is an encounter with the Real Jesus, Present on the altar, placed on my hand or tongue, consumed in my body. So for it to be a life-changing transformation, we have to receive Jesus as consciously

and attentively as possible.

Let me offer a few suggestions. I suggest that if at all possible, you try to read the scripture readings for the Mass before you come. Try to consciously think of an intention for which you'd want to offer Jesus. As you approach the altar, as much as humanly possible, keep your eyes and mind focused on His face, in your mind.

When the priest says to you, "The Body of Christ," try to think that you are holding the Son of God in your very hands as you say, "Amen." What would you want to say to Jesus? There must be something. A word of thanks. A plea for help. A question like, "Why?" For each of us and for each reception, each encounter, there will always be something unique and new.

I leave you on this Corpus Christi with the words of St. Francis of Assisi, who once said, *"Men should tremble. The world should quake. All heaven should be deeply moved, when the Son of God appears on the altar, in the hands of the priest."*



Pope Pius XII shared how the devotion is related to Christ's love for the human race: *"The other reason...arises from the fact that His Heart, more than all the other members of His body, is the natural sign and symbol of His boundless love for the human race. 'There is in the Sacred Heart,' as Our predecessor of immortal memory, Leo XIII, pointed out, 'the symbol and express image of the infinite love of Jesus Christ which moves us to love in return.'*"

The purpose of devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus is to focus our hearts on receiving and returning His love with gratitude — with all of our heart, soul, and strength - that He may be glorified. (<https://www.nationalshrine.org/blog/what-is-the-devotion-to-the-sacred-heart-of-jesus/>). After Jesus came to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque in the 1670s, the Sacred Heart devotion was started. Jesus told her how He wished to be honored with the symbol of His heart, asking for the faithful to make amends for any wrongdoing they had done, frequently take Communion, and observe the Holy Hour. In 1856, the devotion was added to the church calendar by Pope Pius IX. Sacred Heart of Jesus meek and humble of heart, pray for us! May we all take some extra time to spend time with the Sacred Heart of Jesus this month in Adoration!



Peter's Pence Collection June 17-18

The annual Peter's Pence Collection, which will take place next weekend June 17-18, helps Pope Francis provide relief for victims of war, oppression, and natural disaster around the world and supports the various activities of the Holy See.

In August 2021, a powerful earthquake devastated the small island nation of Haiti. More than 2,000 people were killed, 12,000 were injured, and 300 were missing. Then

widespread damage to houses and other structures was worsened by a tropical storm that hit the island shortly afterward. The needs were varied and urgent. Pope Francis donated €200,000 through the Vatican's Dicastery for Promoting Integral Human Development. Those funds supported immediate emergency relief efforts to those most in need.

The Holy Father's response to Haiti is just one example of how the Peter's Pence Collection impacts the lives of those struggling to survive. 


