A MESSAGE FROM YOUR PASTOR

My dear parishioners,

Next weekend we celebrate the Solemnity of Corpus Christi. It is a yearly opportunity to renew our appreciation and understanding of the great gift that Jesus left us at the Last Supper. At a moment when He was preparing His apostles for the physical separation that would happen when He was captured, scourged, crucified and died, He gave them an astounding way of still remaining with them.

Only a God of infinite love, who already humbled Himself by becoming a man subject to pain and death would choose to continue to pour out His love through humble bread and wine. Elements that would become through the human hands and voice of a priest, His Real Presence. His Body and Blood would be given for our nourishment and reassurance that He is with us and wants to be as close to us as our very heart.

This is a gift that we as Catholics treasure. Our First Holy Communion is one of the most important and memorable days of our lives. But so should each reception of Holy Communion every Sunday. Like all good gifts however in life, we can take them for granted. I as a priest have to be careful that what I do each day when I say Mass never becomes routine, without any realization of the miracle that happens each time I say those words: *"Take and eat. This My Body."*

Next weekend in every parish in the United States, we begin the parish phase of a nationwide **Eucharistic Revival**. It's an opportunity to revive our own appreciation of



this Most Blessed Sacrament. We will do that next **Saturday evening June 10**, when we, along with parishioners from neighboring Nativity Parish in Warminster and St. Vincent de Paul in Richboro, will join **at Northampton Municipal Park for an outdoor Eucharistic Corpus Christi Procession**.

Participants are asked to gather around 6:30pm in the parking area of the park, which is on Holland and Bristol Roads in Richboro. Each of the three parishes are responsible for erecting a small temporary altar along the three-quarter mile walk, for we will stop each time for a moment of prayer, reflection and benediction. I encourage all of our First Communicants, Confirmation class children and altar servers to walk in their outfits and robes.

The procession begins and ends near the parking lot to make it easier for everyone. There is additional overflow parking if needed at the Maureen M. Welch Public School.

Let us join as companions on the journey of life, with our neighboring Catholics, to proclaim our faith in Jesus, still Present to this world in the Most Holy Eucharist.

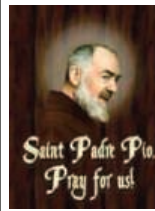

Thank you to everyone who contributed to the Annual Manna Food Drive! This year we collected close to 3,000 pounds of food for Jesus Focus Food Pantry and our pantry here at St. Bede. The drive was manned by our Knights of Columbus who did a fantastic job collecting the food from the donors, packing the trucks, delivering food to the pantry, and sorting food for our pantry here at our church.



It was great to have the Knights assistance and we even were able to have a preview of their new Knights tent. Thank you Ed Bagdon and his team!!

Try and remember to donate food this summer to Jesus Focus. They are open M-F from 9:30-11:30am when food can be dropped off, or on off hours you can leave non perishable items in the shed at the entrance to the pantry which is located at 1030 Second Street Pike. Marcie who directs the pantry said they are feeding more than 40 families a day. The need is great. On arrival she told me the pantry was almost empty and she was so thankful for our donations.

Our food pantry here at St. Bede helps around 10 families a month. Besides the food items given to these families they also receive a gift card to a food store to purchase perishable items. Gift cards to food stores can be purchased in the parish office and left in my mailbox.
