A MESSAGE FROM YOUR PASTOR

My dear parishioners,

This coming June 10 – 11, which is the Solemnity of Corpus Christi (The Body of Christ) marks the beginning of the parish phase of a three-year religious campaign to revive belief among Catholics in the **Real Presence of Jesus in the Most Holy Eucharist**. The three-year campaign, which originated with the Catholic Bishops of the United States, is in response to a recent survey which found that a significant percentage of Catholics consider the Holy Eucharist to be merely a symbol of Jesus and not really and truly His Body and Blood.

One of the many ways the Church has traditionally revived and renewed this belief in the Real Presence has been through public processions on Corpus Christi. Indeed, the highlight of these processions is the carrying through the streets of a monstrance containing the Sacred Consecrated Host for all to see, adore, and contemplate.

I am very happy and excited to announce that we will be conducting a **Corpus Christi Procession on Saturday evening June 10, immediately after our 5:30pm Vigil Mass**. What will make it extra special is the fact that we will combine our efforts with that of two other neighboring parishes: St. Vincent DePaul, Richboro and Nativity of Our Lord, Warminster. This is historic in that it is the first time neighboring parishes in our Northampton community have celebrated our Catholic faith together in such a public way.

The joint procession will take place in **Northampton Municipal Park on Hatboro Road**, and commence around **7:00pm on the Vigil of Corpus Christ, June 10**. The



park is a beautiful and safe setting for our reverent procession, which will include three stops along the one-mile walk, where a short scripture reading, reflection and benediction will take place. The entire procession should last no more than an hour.

The combined choirs of all three parishes will lead the singing, accompanied by the Verdi Band. The times we live in require us to boldly and lovingly proclaim our faith, outside the walls of our churches. The theme of our Corpus Christi procession is “**Companions on the Journey**.” For that is what we are – no matter to what parish we belong. But as the procession will remind us, it is a journey that Jesus walks with us. I hope you will plan to be a part of history.

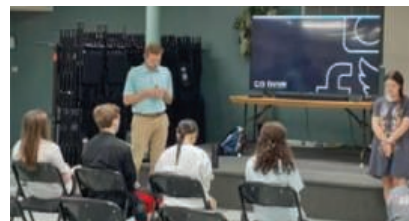
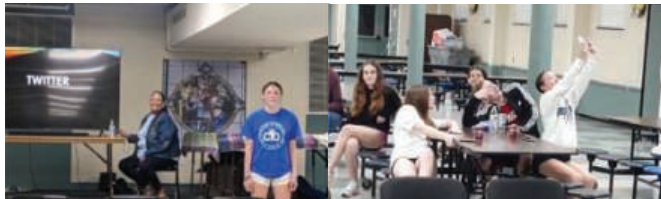
