My dear parishioners,

In the second reading for this weekend's celebration of Pentecost, we hear St. Paul in his first letter to the Corinthians say, *"There are different kinds of spiritual gifts, but the same spirit. There are different forms of service, but the same Lord. To each individual, the manifestation of the Holy Spirit is given for some benefit."*

As pastor of St. Bede Parish, I can attest to the truth of St. Paul's statement. I'm amazed and also gratified to see how so many of you share your gifts and talents for the benefit of the people of this parish, and even beyond.

I think of the parishioners who spend time on Sunday, carrying the Eucharist to the homebound. Legion of Mary, who come to every funeral and pray for the family as they depart for the cemetery.

I am proud of the group of teens on our teen council who use their talents to plan events, to keep our youth connected to the parish. And all of the many Liturgical Ministers, who enhance our worship of God.

While I wish I could mention everyone and every group, the column would go much too long. But everyone is appreciated, and everyone counts in God's eyes. As St. Paul reminded us in that reading, *"Every part of the body is important, and makes it function."*

I encourage anyone who has the time and may be interested or feels called to share their talents or gifts and has not yet done so to come forward. Pray about it, and talk to me. Never underestimate what the Holy Spirit can do, through you, to help renew the face of the earth.

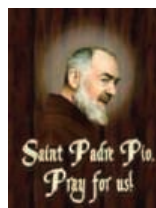

Introduction to Theology of the Body (TOB) by Christopher West (Ascension Press)

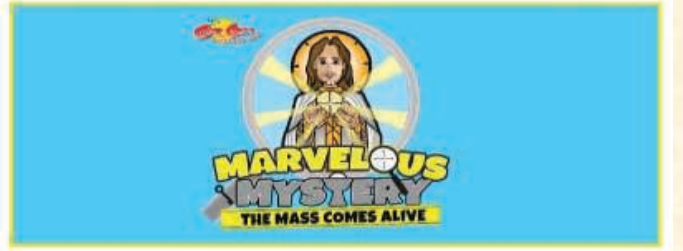

Participants will meet in the Drexel Center Room B to view an engaging video presentation preceded by a time of lively group discussion and fellowship, dynamically taught by world renowned speaker, Dr. Christopher West. **This course is designed to give you a solid understanding of God's plan for humanity.
