### A MESSAGE FROM YOUR PASTOR

My dear parishioners,

Last Ash Wednesday, some slight but nonetheless important changes were introduced to the Rite of Penance, the sacrament most of us as Catholics simply refer to as confession. Although it was several months ago that this change occurred, to be honest I am just getting around to explaining the change, and only within the past two months have I begun to use some of the optional yet beautiful additions that are suggested when I hear confessions.

For example, now as soon as the penitent enters the confessional, the priest says, "Welcome." And then together, priest and penitent say, "In the name of the Father, and the Son, and the Holy Spirit, Amen." The priest continues with these beautiful words, "May God who has shone His light into our hearts, grant that you may truly know your sins and His mercy."

At that point, the penitent confesses their sins, starting with the traditional form of "Bless me Father, for I have sinned. It has been \_\_\_\_ since my last confession. And these are my sins." The priest may offer suitable counsel, and proposes a suitable work of penance. He then invites the penitent to pray an Act of Contrition.

By the way, the penitent can pray the Act of Contrition, which we all learned as children, or use his/her own original words (in our confessional at St. Bede, we offer little white cards for the person who forgets the words). This is followed by the priest extending his hand over the penitent, and reciting the words of absolution. The priest now says in the revised form that "God **pours out** the Holy Spirit, and that God **grants** you pardon and peace." The richness of the new language, as minor as it may seem, is nonetheless helpful. God is granting something that we don't deserve, and that's what forgiveness is. It's not something that we earn or deserve – God graciously **grants** it.

The final part of the Rite concludes with the priest saying, "Give thanks to the Lord, for He is good," to which

the penitent responds, "For His mercy endures forever." Then the priest dismisses the penitent with, "The Lord has forgiven your sins. Go in peace."

You know, I often hear people tell me how uplifting and relieved they are after the Sacrament of Reconciliation. Especially if they've been away for a long time. And when I say a long time it ranges from the two-year period of COVID, where people stayed away, and as far as 30 to 45 years ago. Inevitably people will say, "I feel like a burden has been lifted," because that's what's happening. God is casting behind His back all our sins, taking them away from us in a way that we cannot do for ourselves, no matter how hard we try.

The Lord takes upon Himself all our sins in confession, because that is what the cross is all about. That He takes all of our sins to the cross, so that we don't have to.

May God bless you.
