Scenes from our Patriotic Concert

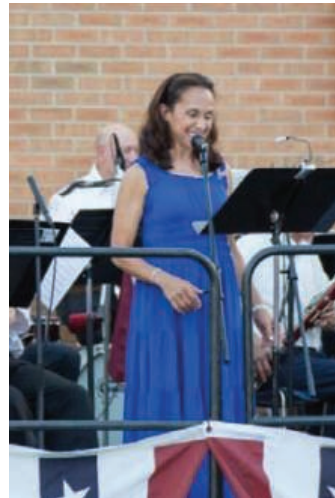



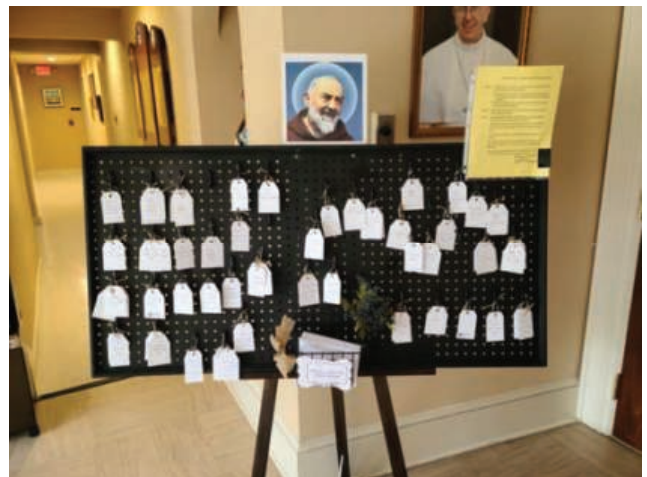
