A MESSAGE FROM YOUR PASTOR

My dear parishioners,
"I've been to the mountaintop, and I have seen the Promised Land. I might not get there with you, but I have found the peace of the nations."

Those were the last publically recorded words of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., given impromptu the night before he was assassinated in April, 1968. Dr. King will always be known in American history as the leader of the American Civil Rights movement of the 1960's, but he is known internationally as a promoter of human justice and peace, in a nation and during a period of history that were fraught with violence and war.

Dr. King used non-violent disobedience as his method to achieve change. Influenced by the Baptist Minister and social reformer Walter Rauschenbusch, Henry David Thoreau's famous essay "On the Duty of Civil Disobedience," and the non-violence practiced by the Indian freedom fighter Mahatma Gandhi, King developed a system of nonviolent resistance that totally disarmed the forces against which he was matched. Dr. King's actions and ideas were recognized by the world in 1964, when he was awarded the Nobel Peace Prize. Yes, Martin Luther King had been to the mountaintop and seen the peace that only Christ can bring.

Martin Luther King's approach to life serves as an excellent example of the message of peace in this weekend's readings. Zachariah proclaiming God's message to the Hebrews after their return from exile in Babylon says that **God's ways to achieve the renewal that the community seeks is through meekness and**

peace. Force, anger, and violence brought death to both Israel, the northern kingdom, and Judah, the southern kingdom. Thus the prophet offers a new way, the only way to a new Israel: the way of peace.

We live in a highly competitive world that demands performance and achievement. It is by such marks of accomplishment that our value is measured today. This is unfortunately to our great undoing and even shame, at times. We feel that we cannot get ahead unless we fight and claw our way to the top. If we run over a few people in the process – so be it. They were the weak, and society today is survival of the fittest.

But in the Gospel, Jesus fortunately has the perfect antidote. *"Come to me," Jesus says, "All you who labor and are burdened, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am meek and humble of heart, and you will find rest for yourselves. For my yoke is easy and my burden is light."* Jesus asked that we bring our problems to Him. He asked that we take His attitude in our dealings with others. Certainly we need to do our best utilizing the gifts, talents, and opportunities we possess. But we can do this without an attitude of violence, greed or selfishness. Jesus came to our world as an innocent child, and rode triumphantly yet meekly into Jerusalem to the shouts of Hosanna, five days before His salvific death for us.

Let us take a similar attitude of humility for others who we know and associate with in our lives. Let us treat all as would Christ. Let us see and believe, as did Martin Luther King Jr., that peace is the way to success. And more importantly, to salvation and eternal life.

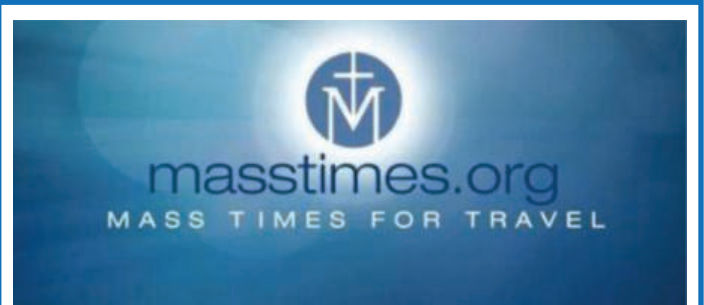

That inspiring story of Chile's first saint, and America's newest and youngest saint, is revealed in this definitive film on St. Teresa of the Andes. We celebrate her feast day on July 13.



This biographical drama tells the true story of Pedro Poveda (1874 – 1936), a tenacious and innovative priest who opened new paths in education and pioneered the rights of women in the early twentieth century. A victim of intolerance, he was murdered at the outbreak of the Spanish Civil War. In 1974, he was awarded the title of "Educator and Humanist" by UNESCO and was canonized a saint by Pope John Paul II in 2003. His feast day is July 28.

Poveda's success in educating and promoting poor illiterate children living in the Caves of Guadix in Southern Spain received staunch opposition. He continued his work in spite of the social and political turmoil that intensified in the beginning of the thirties and escalated into a civil war. Caught in the middle of the conflict, Poveda, a man of peace and dialogue, gave his life for his faith, leaving behind a legacy of light and hope."
