My World Youth Day Experience

This past summer, I had the incredible opportunity to travel to Portugal for 18 days with a group of students from my school Holy Ghost Prep, to participate in World Youth Day. World Youth Day is a global gathering with the Pope, celebrated approximately every 3-4 years. The most recent World Youth Day was hosted in Lisbon, Portugal August 1 to 6. As part of my school group we embarked on a pilgrimage, exploring various cities in Portugal.

During the initial phase of the trip, we divided into small groups of two and were graciously hosted by kind families in a village just outside of Barcelos. There, we deepened our connection with God by attending daily Mass and immersing ourselves in diverse cultures from people worldwide. We formed friendships with young people from different countries and engaged in various daily activities. Our itinerary included visits to Barcelos and, the following day, to Fatima. In Fatima, I had the privilege of witnessing the stunning basilicas, exploring Francisco's house, and seeing the bed where he passed away. I participated in Mass and attended a candlelight service. I also did a challenging knee walk from the Basilica of the Most Holy Trinity to the Chapel of Adorations and back again. This is a famous walk on your knees that pilgrims do as an act of penance.

After Fatima, I resided at the Spiritan headquarters just outside of Lisbon for the remainder of the trip. In Lisbon, I caught a glimpse of the Pope during a ceremony from a not-so-distant vantage point. For the final leg of our journey, we embarked on a long pilgrimage to attend a night vigil, spent the night outdoors in sleeping bags, and woke up to join 1.5 million others for Sunday Mass with the Pope. The trip had its share of stressful moments, particularly regarding transportation due to the large number of attendees, but it was an incredible experience. This pilgrimage profoundly strengthened my faith, creating memories I will cherish forever. Undoubtedly, it was a once-in-a-lifetime opportunity to share this experience with my school.

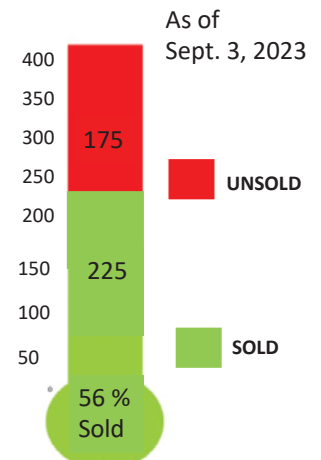
