A MESSAGE FROM YOUR PASTOR

My dear parishioners,

In my 18 years as your pastor, I've experienced countless moments when I have been so proud and thankful for what we together have accomplished. But last weekend's Padre Pio Festival ranks way up at the top of that list.

I thank Archbishop Nelson Perez, who led our celebration of Mass in honor of Padre Pio. I think he said it best in the first sentence he uttered after making the sign of the cross when he declared, "Is this a celebration or what?" Last weekend was a celebration of a saint who is loved around the world and his example of faithfulness to God's will has inspired and given hope to people at a time in history when we need inspiration and hope.

Let me take this opportunity to thank everyone involved in pulling off such a huge event with precision, planning, organization and a tremendous sense of hospitality.

In a special way I join you in thanking Northampton Township officials and Police Department for their total cooperation and support for what has become one of the biggest events in this community.

Now that we have been designated as the Archdiocesan Shrine of Padre Pio, many parishioners have asked me, "So what does it really mean? Where or what is the Shrine?" Well the Shrine is first of all the beautiful statue of Padre Pio in our church. It is a shrine because we house a relic of his blood from the stigmata he endured every time he celebrated Mass.

In the near future, we will transfer one of the rooms located near the main entrance to our church into an exhibit of his life and teachings, and a small gift shop. Already we have received calls from people, like a woman who asked if she could bring a friend of hers who is battling cancer to be blessed with the relic. A high school religion teacher asked if he could bring his theology class for a visit and explanation of the life of Padre Pio. Together we will see where the Good Lord takes us with this new designation.

I can tell you this: miracles have happened here at St. Bede's through Padre Pio's intercession. During last weekend's festival, I was privileged to meet the recipients of two miracles, and hear their stories. In fact, you can read several testimonies of cures attributed to Padre Pio's intercession on our Padre Pio Festival website.

Please take a look at the more extended thank you letter on page 5 of this weekend's bulletin. Our most important thank you goes to our dear Lord Jesus and His Blessed Mother Mary, who provided us with beautiful weather, and for such a wonderful saint to imitate, in Padre Pio.

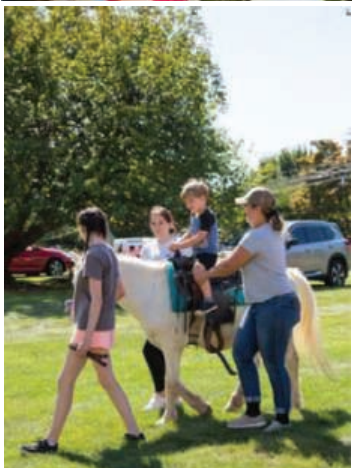

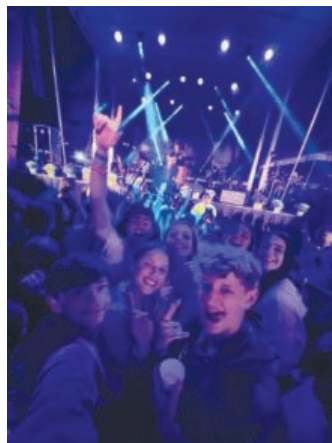

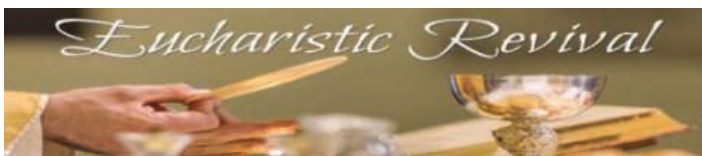
