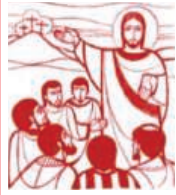

A MESSAGE FROM YOUR PASTOR

My dear parishioners,

With the arrival of the Labor Day weekend holiday, the campus of St. Bede Parish will begin to come alive once again after the relative quiet of the summer months. Already our CYO soccer teams have begun practice under the lights, and the famous Friday night games will soon

resume.

This week, St. Katharine Drexel School reopens its doors for the beginning of academic year 2023-24 with the highest enrollment since I first arrived here in 2005, with **an expected 457 students from pre-kindergarten to eighth grade.** I am proud of our school's excellent reputation for academic excellence, as well as overall commitment to the mission of forming future Catholic leaders for our world and our Church through personal discipline, Christian service, and faithful adherence to the unchanging Truth of the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

In fact a week ago, the Archdiocese of Philadelphia's Office of Catholic Education awarded St. Katharine Drexel Regional School the title **"School of Distinguished Instruction, as a Result of Growth and Exceeding Potential."** I always like to report this information to all parishioners since your weekly generous contributions helps subsidize the cost of educating our children, along with the tuition and fundraising of our school parents.

This week also marks the beginning of our RCIA, which stands for the **"Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults."** The RCIA is the process by which those adults who have never been baptized or baptized but never received the other sacraments prayerfully learn and discern whether or not God is calling them to full member-

ship in the Catholic Church.

The RCIA starts off this Thursday evening **September 7 with an Information and Inquiry Night, starting at 7:00pm in the Drexel Center.** This affords those interested an opportunity to discover how the process works, what is involved, etc. Already we have a class of four adults, and usually others show up at the Information Night.

If you or someone you know would benefit from this opportunity to deepen their faith in Jesus Christ, encourage them to attend. The team who guides the presentations, along with Fr. Ryan and me, are adult parishioners who enjoy sharing their faith with others. While there is a definite topic discussed and explained each week, the RCIA affords participants the opportunity to question, discuss and simply share the journey of faith with others. It's one of my favorite parts of being a priest.

Pope Saint John Paul II comments on labor (or work) in his document, **LABOREM EXERCENS**: "THROUGH WORK man must earn his daily bread and contribute to the continual advance of science and technology and, above all, to elevating unceasingly the cultural and moral level of the society within which he lives in community with those who belong to the same family."

R.C.I.A- STORIES OF FAITH

R.C.I.A Stories of Faith is an outreach of St. Bede the Venerable to open the doors to the Catholic Church by explaining the R.C.I.A process to our community and spreading the stories of our parish members who have participated in the program here and as part of their own personal faith journey into full communion with the Catholic Church.

What is R.C.I.A.?

R.C.I.A. stands for Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults. RCIA is the process established by the Universal Church for individuals to become Catholic and receive the sacraments of initiation-Baptism, Confirmation and the Eucharist. This initiation process involves a parish community experiencing a renewal of faith as it prepares and welcomes new members into the Church. The Rite speaks of conversion as a "spiritual journey." St. Bede's R.C.I.A. program runs from September 14 to May 2 on Thursday nights at 7:00 pm in the Drexel Center.

The Ultimate Story of Faith

The ultimate story of faith is the story of a baby boy born in Bethlehem, in a manger. It is a story of a boy raised by his father and mother, Joseph and Mary. It is a story of a family and their son, a Jewish boy that becomes a man, yet not only a man, but the Savior of the World. "For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him might not perish but might have eternal life." (John 3:16). This is the story of Jesus, the story of the Christ who gave himself on the Cross so that you may be made whole, healed of your brokenness and be with God in heaven forever.

Who is R.C.I.A. for?

1. Persons who want to learn more about Jesus; 2) Persons interested in exploring and interested in the Catholic faith; 3) Persons in need of Baptism; 4) Persons baptized in another Christian tradition who desire to become Catholic; and 5) Persons baptized Catholic in need of First Communion and/or Confirmation.

Adult Faith Formation: "Lectio: Eucharist"

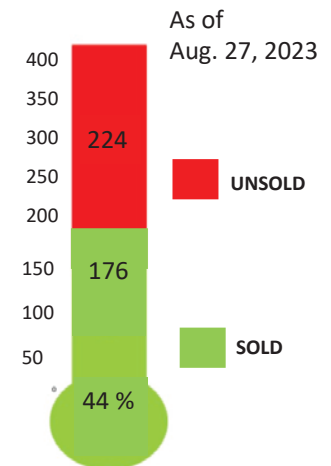

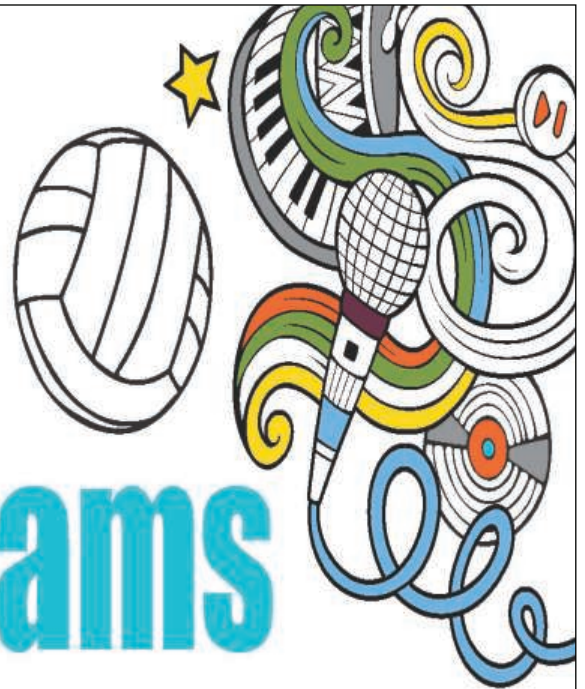
