A MESSAGE FROM YOUR PASTOR

My dear parishioners,

This weekend we begin our annual **Forty Hours Devotion**. This is a Catholic tradition whereby the consecrated Eucharist (A Host that has become the Body and Blood of Christ at the consecration of a Mass) is exposed on our altar in a

Monstrance, which is a special container with a small window. The purpose of exposition is so that the faithful can adore Jesus in this sacrament over a period of Forty Hours. This all happens over the course of three days, starting after the 12:30pm Mass this Sunday Oct. 1, and ending with the closing outdoor procession on Tuesday evening, Oct. 3.

The term "Forty Hours" comes from the forty hours that Christ's Body traditionally spent in the tomb. Forty is a significant number in the Bible, often tied to trials and suffering. The Israelites wandered in the desert for 40 years. Christ retreated into the desert for 40 days, where He was tempted by the devil prior to the start of His public ministry.

St. John Neumann, the fourth Bishop of the Archdiocese of Philadelphia, was the first Church leader to start the practice here in America. At the time Catholics faced great opposition here in Philadelphia during the No-Nothing riots of 1844. At that time, anti-Catholic protesters burned two churches and continued to foster animosity towards Catholics in the city.

Several of the priests at that time discouraged Bishop Neumann, believing it might fan the flames of anti-Catholic sentiment. But Neumann refused to listen, telling his priests to not fear. We live in a time when rejection of



Catholic moral teaching has caused animosity towards Catholics once again. Like Bishop Neumann we must not fear for we have the **Real Presence** of Jesus accompanying us in this journey of faith.

This will be quite evident on Tuesday night, when as part of the conclusion of Forty Hours, we carry the monstrance with the Most Blessed Sacrament outside of church accompanied by the light of our little candles and experience Jesus walking with us.

This year we welcome my seminary classmate **Archbishop James P. Green**, who will lead us

through the Forty Hours by his inspiring homilies. To highlight the special quality of the celebration, close to 35 priests, many of them former Parochial Vicars here, are joining us for this very grace-filled moment in our parish life.

Pope St. John Paul II once said, *"Jesus awaits us in this sacrament. This sign of His love."* I hope you will accept His invitation and spend some time with Him.

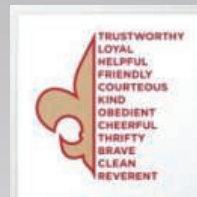

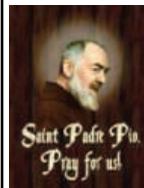
