


A MESSAGE FROM YOUR PASTOR

My dear parishioners,

As I mentioned in a previous column several weeks ago, St. Charles Borromeo Seminary, one of the many pride and joys of our historic Archdiocese, will be moving from its famous location in Overbrook with the end of this current academic year in June, 2024. At this time, construction of the new seminary buildings on the campus of Gwynedd Mercy College is in full swing. The Archdiocese could not financially keep up with the tremendous maintenance needs of a massive campus built for several hundred seminarians of yesteryear.

The seminary building was a place that all the priests who have served you here at St. Bede and more than likely at other parishes where you were born or grew up or educated, were trained and formed. For us priests, this is a truly bittersweet moment. Sweet in that we know the formation of future priests that is renowned throughout the world will continue at the Gwynedd location. Nonetheless bitter in that the memories and the physical beauty of the campus which resembles the architecture and art of Italy will be left behind.

Several artifacts will be transported to the new campus, but obviously, not everything will fit into a much smaller footprint. Those that cannot fit have been made available for parishes throughout the country to repurpose at their location.

I am happy to announce that I secured two large paintings that had been housed for close to 100 years in the Immaculate Conception Chapel of our seminary's Theology division. The matching paintings portray the Transfiguration of Our Lord on Mount Tabor, and the




*Isaiah 45: 1, 4-6

Isaiah speaks to Cyrus in our first reading. Cyrus was a king of Persia who conquered Babylon and liberated the Jewish people. In this reading, we see that it was the Lord who called Cyrus into action on behalf of the Jews. This reading gives a good preparation for the Gospel story about repaying Caesar what belongs to Caesar. For in the end, does not everything belong to God?





Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

On Oct. 22, we will join Catholics worldwide to observe **World Mission Sunday** by celebrating the love of the Lord and help bring the Good News to all corners of the earth.

Inspired by the story of the disciples on the way to Emmaus, Pope Francis chose this year's theme, "*Hearts on fire, feet on the move.*" He invites us to reflect on these images, *their hearts burned within them* as they

heard the Scriptures explained by Jesus, their eyes were opened as they recognized Him and, ultimately, *their feet set out on the way*. As Missionary disciples, we seek inspiration in the Scriptures. We also look to the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist as the source and summit of the Church's mission so we can evangelize with zeal and urgency.




