


### A MESSAGE FROM YOUR PASTOR

My dear parishioners,

This has certainly been a busy few weeks here at St. Bede's but at the same time, exciting and inspirational. We just barely finished reveling in this year's Padre Pio Festival, when now many of us are joyfully reflecting on this past week's celebration of the Forty Hours Devotion.

Judging again by the comments you shared with me, it appears that Archbishop Green's homilies each of the three nights had a profound effect. On the first night, he spoke about the **gratitude** we should have when we realize that God so loved us that becoming one of us in Jesus of Nazareth was not enough. For this infinitely generous God chose also to remain with us in the form of bread that through what the Church calls "transubstantiation" becomes substantially His Body and Blood, "Soul and Divinity." The Eucharist then is the **Sacrament of Gratitude**.

On Monday night Archbishop Green reminded us that just as the bread and wine carried in the offertory procession, are transformed at the consecration, so too when we receive Christ into our hearts, His mission is to transform us so that we can become more and more like Him: Generous. Kind. Merciful. Unto eternal life. The Eucharist then is the **Sacrament of Transformation**.

And then on Tuesday night, the Archbishop made it clear that the Eucharist is the **Sacrament of Evangelization**. If all the above is true, then like our Blessed Mother who carried Jesus in her womb, we who have received Jesus in Holy Communion become the bearers of hope and light and truth to a darkened, hopeless world.

### Scripture Readings for Next Sunday Twenty-eighth Sunday in Ordinary Time October 15, 2023

Isaiah 25: 6-10a

Psalm 23: 1-3a, 3b-6

Philippians 4: 12-14, 19-20

Matthew 22: 1-14 or 1-10

What a wonderful reading we have from Isaiah! It presents the image of the messianic banquet, a time of abundance and grace from God. Jesus too presents a banquet story, but His parable introduces a qualification at the end. Consider that we are among the guests recruited from the main roads, "bad and good alike." We are still expected to prepare ourselves. How are you preparing yourself for the heavenly banquet?



Archbishop Green and his homilies kept everyone's attention focused on the Sacrament of the Eucharist.

It proves that life is not meaningless. God has not given up on our world, for He is as present as that Sacred Host that we carry in our heart.

I loved Archbishop Green's talks because they are the "blueprint" for the Eucharistic Revival in our parish. If you were unable to attend the Forty Hours, you can at least hear his homily at the weekend Masses and closing ceremony by accessing them on our Facebook page and website.

I conclude my column with the words which Archbishop Green ended each homily: "O Sacrament Most Holy! O Sacrament Divine! All praise and all thanksgiving be every moment Thine.
