My dear parishioners,

As I have mentioned on several occasions, I am blessed as your pastor to be surrounded by many good advisors, especially our **Parish Pastoral Council and Finance Council**. - ◆ Goal 5: Maintain the fiscal stability of the parish through prudent stewardship of resources and growth in sharing time, talent and treasure.
- ◆ Goal 6: Maintain and continuously review the plan that will ensure that our worship, school, religious education programs and all parish activities are safe and secure for all participants.

Under each goal, the members of the Parish Pastoral Council have also devised several objectives which, along

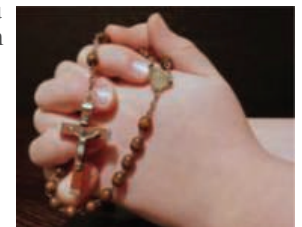

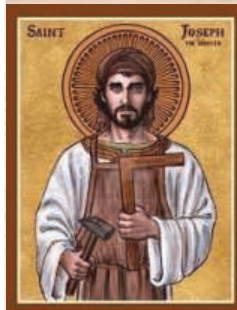
