A MESSAGE FROM YOUR PASTOR

My dear parishioners,

When her Uncle Tom died at age 75 this summer, Cynthia knew the kind of memorial he would want. "It was important for our family that he had a funeral Mass because he was a very devout Catholic," said Cynthia. Going to weekly Mass each Sunday, and when he was no longer able to leave his home, watching it on livestream, was the highlight of his week. "Because of that we felt he deserved a Mass dedicated to his honor, and praying for his quick entry into heaven," she said.

When November, the month of the Holy Souls rolls around, I often like to mention funeral practices because in our current world, many families of those who pass onto eternal life increasingly bypass the funeral Mass, electing instead to have a service elsewhere, often in a funeral parlor or simply graveside. It is particularly sad for me as a pastor when I know the deceased person was someone of deep faith, and the family members decide not to have a funeral Mass because they do not see its importance.

Sometimes families unfortunately opt for their personal convenience, rather than celebrating more fully the life of the deceased through the dignified prayer, which is the Mass. For at the Mass we as Catholics believe the Communion of Saints is convoked or gathered, and those in heaven, those in purgatory, and those of us here on earth encircle our deceased loved one with the merits and benefits that come from the Eucharist. With the celebration of a funeral Mass, we help usher our loved one with our prayers into the arms of God, and the healing process that is needed for the family has its beginning.

Besides, a well celebrated funeral is an opportunity for



evangelization. Many times it helps to bring people back to the Church, and a deeper understanding of the meaning of life and death, and the Good News of eternal life in Jesus Christ.

I strongly encourage you my parishioners to make your wishes known to your children that when God calls you home, they have your funeral celebrated within a Mass. Many parents actively plan their funeral ahead, picking out the readings and hymns. This takes the pressure away from your survivors at a time when they are grieving. We can offer you a guidebook to help you.

Finally a note about the necessity of burial. The Church believes and teaches that the body is sacred. It is the Temple of the Holy Spirit, and of our soul, whether in full body form or cremation. And therefore the cremains need to be buried soon after the funeral, if not the same day, to preserve that sacredness. The Church does not want us scattered in a park or over our favorite body of water, or sitting on a mantelpiece.

May this month of November remind us of our deceased loved ones, and recall the words of the funeral Mass: "For those who are faithful to the Lord Jesus, life does not end, it merely changed."

GUEST SPEAKER AT ALL MASSES THIS WEEKEND COMPREHENSIVE CAPITAL CAMPAIGN FOR SAINT CHARLES SEMINARY



This weekend we welcome Father Jason Buck, who will preach the homily at all the Masses. His focus will be on the historic relocation of our beloved Saint Charles Seminary from its present site to its new campus on property purchased from Gwynedd Mercy University, in Gwynedd Township, Montgomery County.



In the pictures you will see the architect's rendering of what will be the new building of Saint Charles Seminary, which has often and rightfully so been call "The heartbeat of the Archdiocese of Philadelphia." It is a school of formation for future priests, and the future of the Catholic Church here in our area. Your help and mine will be needed to help finance this project, which benefits every Catholic in the five counties of the Archdiocese. The Comprehensive Capital Campaign to which Father Buck will address is different from the annual Seminary Appeal, in November.

I encourage you to pray for the success of these appeals, which are so important to the mission of evangelization.

Father Buck is familiar to many people in our area for he recently served as a Parochial Vicar at St. Andrew, Newtown. He is currently Dean of Formation at Saint Charles Seminary.

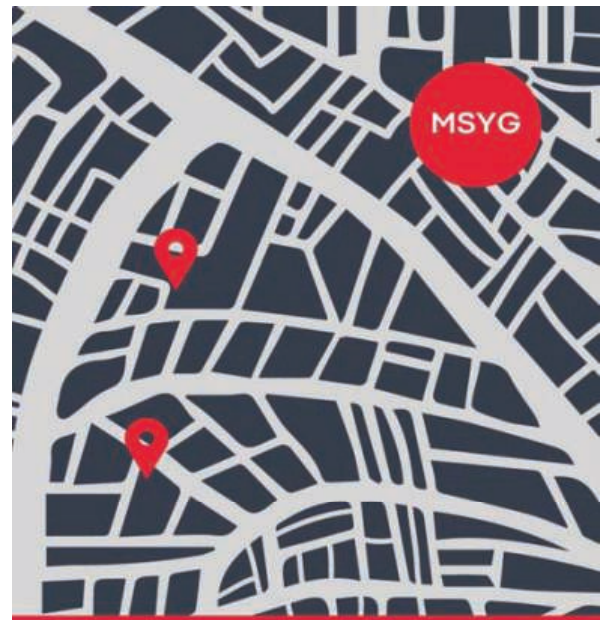


MIDDLE SCHOOL YOUTH GROUP NEWS!
