

Anointing of the Sick - In case of serious illness (or advanced age), please call the priests.

Hospital cases should contact the Chaplain, but the Parish Office should be notified so one of the priests may visit the patient.

A MESSAGE FROM YOUR PASTOR

My dear parishioners,

So this coming Thursday we gather with family and friends to celebrate the one national holiday that has clear, definite religious overtones. And that, of course, is Thanksgiving. It raises the question, Why is Thanksgiving to God so essential? Why did the return of the one leper out of ten to give thanks to Jesus win so much praise from the Lord?

When we are grateful, we have greater happiness and satisfaction in our lives. We are more alert and attentive to recognize the satisfaction that already exists in our lives, without having to look for more. That quest for more can be suffocating to the point that we are never happy or grateful for what is right in front of us.

Gratitude lifts our spirits and self-worth. Sometimes we compare ourselves too much to others, to the point that we forget what we have. Gratitude helps us to sense God's presence in our lives. We can become too "me" centered, and forget that all we have ultimately is from God.

A thankful attitude reveals solutions to challenges we cannot see on our own. Be thankful, in other words, for that friend who tells you the truth, even if it hurts. Be thankful you have someone in your life like that.

Notice in the word "gratitude" is the word "attitude." If we train our children to have the attitude of entitlement and not gratitude, we are not preparing them for the real world. How easy it is to forget the many good things we already have in life, and concentrate on what we do not have.

I suggest something I find helpful: from time to time I look at old family albums and recall relatives and friends who touched my life, yet are no longer with me. My parents, grandparents, aunts, uncles, teachers, priests. I remember the blessings they brought into my life. They were not perfect, and like me, had their flaws. But I see them and I say, "Thank you, Lord."

At every Mass, but especially the Mass we celebrate here at St. Bede on Thanksgiving Day, we come to the heart of the liturgy, at the consecration. When the priest repeats the words of Jesus, "Do this in remembrance of Me." And when we hear those words we are asked to remember the greatest reason for Thanksgiving: that God in His Son Jesus loves us so much, that He became one of us, that we might have eternal life.

So I invite you to come to Mass on Thanksgiving Day at 9:00am, and recall all that you and I have received from the Hand of the Lord.






