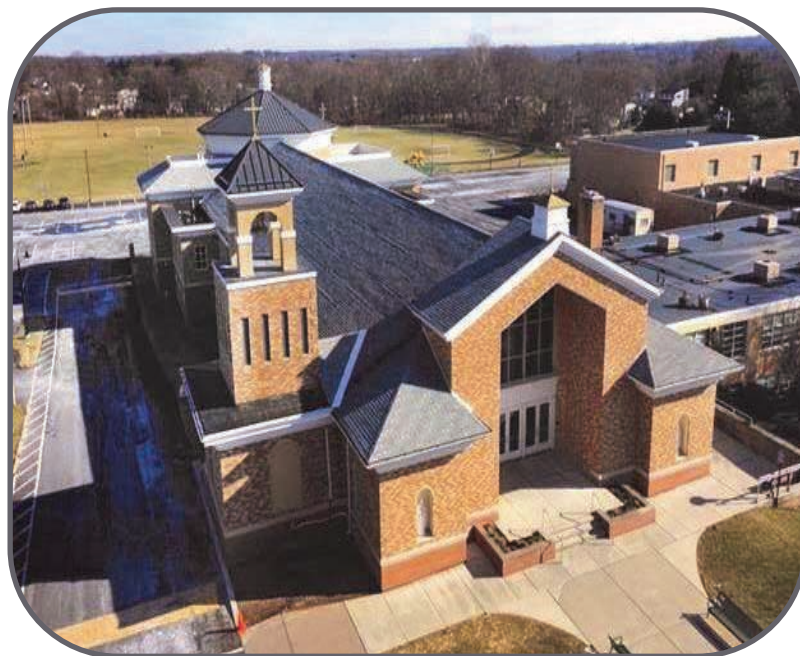

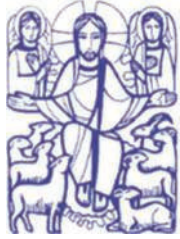

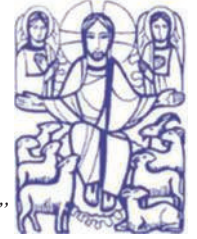
**Anointing of the Sick** - In case of serious illness (or advanced age), please call the priests.

## A MESSAGE FROM YOUR PASTOR

My dear parishioners,

Today we celebrate the final Sunday of the Church’s Liturgical year, with the **Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe**. I always like this feast because it reminds me, as it should all of you, of the two most important realities in our life. The first is that **Jesus must**

**always be FIRST**, since He is our King. We all have loyalties to family, sports teams, political ideologies, etc. But in the end, they all must take second place to our relationship with Jesus. He is not a dogma, an ideology, or a myth. Jesus is a PERSON.

The second reality is that Jesus is the beginning and ending of all life, history, and the universe. When our life comes to an end, it is to He that we will go. And it is He who will judge us. All life, all our decisions, come down to that moment. Let us live our lives not in fear, but nonetheless with the realization that time marches on to the moment when we will see our King face to face. May each day then be another opportunity to serve Jesus above all others.

Advent, the season of preparation for the coming of Jesus at Christmas, begins next Sunday. One of the purposes of Advent is for us to be vigilant to recognize the coming of Jesus in those around us. In the Gospel for today’s Feast of Christ the King, Jesus says, “Whatsoever you do to the least of my brothers and sisters, you do to Me.”

During that first week of Advent, we will open the doors of our church for the members of the Hispanic community of St. Patrick Church in Norristown, who will join us for our annual **Advent Gift Giving Mass on Wednesday night, December 6**. These representatives will receive our packaged Christmas gifts, which they will carefully distribute to the needy Catholic families in their parish.

I hope that you will find time to join us for this inspiring liturgy, which will be celebrated by Fr. Manuel Flores, the pastor of St. Patrick’s. Come and honor Christ the King, who we will see in the faces of those who need our help.

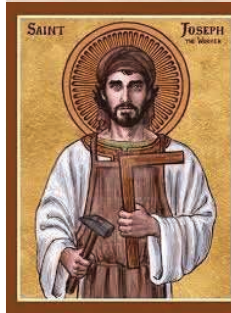

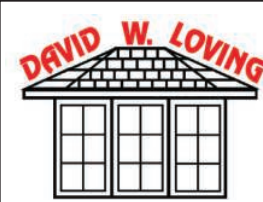
