A MESSAGE FROM YOUR PASTOR

My dear parishioners,

Today we begin to celebrate the Sundays in Ordinary Time. The Feast of Christmas the Holy Family and the Solemnity of Mary are all over. The sacristans have put away our white vestments and we are back to just ordinary green.

But there is nothing ordinary about Ordinary Time, because in the Sundays of this liturgical season, we begin to rediscover what Christmas and the events of Christ’s birth call us to do with our lives. We don’t just put Christ away in the closet like we put our Nativity set away.

I know what you may be thinking: “We’re just regular people with jobs and families, just trying to live a good life. What could the Lord God possibly call ordinary people like us to do?”

Today’s Gospel reveals at least one thing. God is inviting all of us to do something that is within the reach of any of us: to point the way to Christ and invite others to join us on the journey of faith. In the Gospel for this weekend, John the Baptist points his disciples to Jesus. They seek Him, and after spending time with Jesus, have been convinced that they have found not just another Rabbi, but someone greater – the Messiah.

Having arrived at this significant realization, how did Andrew respond? He went and brought his brother Simon Peter to Jesus. Was Simon reluctant at first? Probably. But he could sense the enthusiasm in Andrew’s voice, and said, “Okay, take me to Him.” Had Andrew not invited his brother, history could have been much different.

How many of us have someone in our lives who



doesn’t know Jesus? They may have gone to Catholic School or CCD, but perhaps they do not know the joy of truly knowing Him. Of trusting in Him. Of encountering His love, His forgiveness, His healing and His mercy. We probably all know someone in that category. And so, this is our encouragement to not shy away from inviting our family members to meet Christ.

In his letter to the Corinthians today, Paul reminds us that we are “Temples of the Holy Spirit.” Next time we find ourselves in conversation with a family member, and feel that strong sense that we should invite them to give Jesus a chance, let us ask the Holy Spirit in us for help. The Holy Spirit can fill us with the courage to speak, to listen, and to lovingly extend an invitation to our family member to an encounter with Christ. Then trust that God will take it from there.
