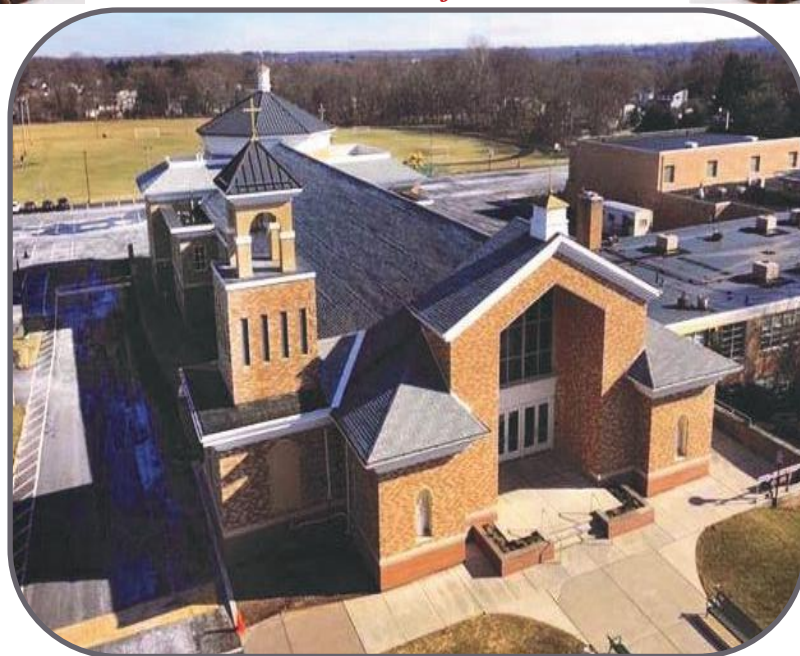

A MESSAGE FROM YOUR PASTOR

My dear parishioners,

The National Effort for Eucharistic Revival has been underway for over a year now. This revival reminds us that no part of human existence brings us as near to Jesus as the Eucharist. Jesus Himself tells us in direct words: *"I am the Bread of Life. Whoever comes to Me will never hunger."*

But that intimate encounter won't happen if we do not come prepared. Recently while in Florida for a week, I took some time to visit family members who lived there and who I have not seen for a few years. We planned lunch. And as I drove there, I thought of all the things I wanted to remember to share with them about my life since we last met. And I tried to imagine what they might share with me. I was preparing for this special time.

That is the kind of anticipation that we must bring to the Eucharist. For while our encounter with Jesus reaches its high point at Mass, where we receive His Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity. Nevertheless it must continue in other ways, both prior to our next Mass and in those days after Sunday.

The Season of Lent is a good time to make an agreement with God that we will keep in touch all week, through prayer, and before we sit down together at the Sacred Meal of Sunday Eucharist. I would like to call that agreement a "pact." Those four letters form an acronym that reminds us of the Four Pillars of Prayer. And what are they?

P: Petition. Pray for all those who are sick. All in need, in your family. Those you miss. Those you are estranged from. Or who are deceased. Then pray for your own needs, starting off with petitions. It is an easy way to get going.

A: Adoration. With the angels and saints in heaven, imagine you are worshipping God the Father, seated on the throne. Adore His Son, our Savior, with deep love and devotion. Praise the Holy Spirit, who empowers us to rise above our humanness.

C: Contrition. Express your sorrow to the Lord. Where did you fail to love God as much as you should have this past week? Where did you fail to love your family? Neighbors? Co-workers? Friends? And self?

T: Thanksgiving. God's blessings are countless. How has God blessed you and your loved ones this week? Take a moment to thank God.

Our encounter with the Lord on Sunday takes practice and preparation. But if we make that our Lenten goal, it will be well worth the effort.

May God bless you.

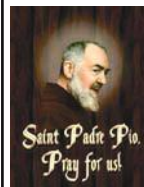

Mr. Shawn Tobin's story of Our Lady: Our Lady of Lourdes: Feast Day- Feb. 11:

Our Lady came to Bernadette Soubirous, a poor peasant girl, in 1858, four years after Mary was declared the Immaculate Conception. She was dressed all in white, with a blue belt fastened around her waist and golden yellow roses, one on each foot, the color of her rosary. On Feb. 24, Bernadette related that Mary asked for prayer and penance for the conversion of sinners. On the next day, she asked her to dig in the ground and drink from the spring that would erupt. As word spread, the water was given to medical patients, and many reports of miraculous cures followed. The government fenced off the area. Bernadette visited the barricaded Grotto and on March 25, Our Lady said, "I am the Immaculate Conception." To this day, Lourdes is a place of pilgrimage.



Miracles occur in the stream that Bernadette found, which now has baths connected to it. Lourdes reminds us to pray for sinners and affirms the Dogma of the Immaculate Conception of Mary. Our Lady of Lourdes, pray for us!

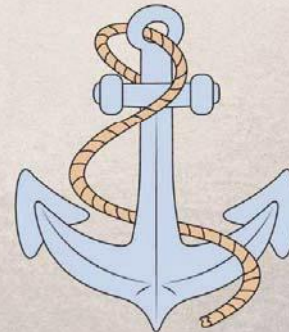

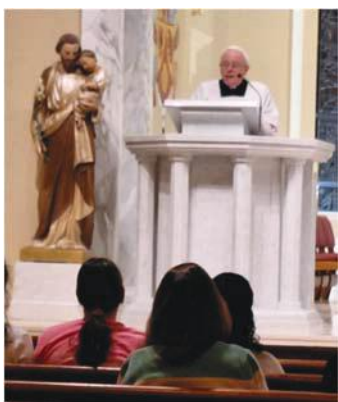
