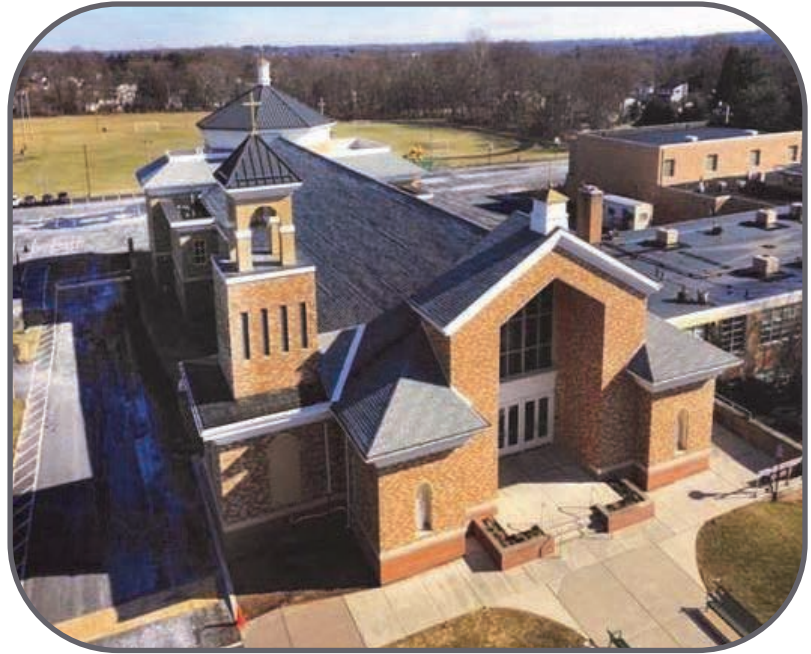

A MESSAGE FROM YOUR PASTOR

My dear parishioners,

This weekend we are honored as a parish to welcome **Bishop Christopher Cooke** to St. Bede, to lead our annual **Lenten Mission**. Bishop Cooke is one of the three priests from the archdiocese selected by Pope Francis, along with Bishops Keith Chylinski and Efen Esmilla, who were ordained on March 7 as Auxiliary Bishops of Philadelphia.

Bishop Cooke is no stranger to our community because as a native son of Northampton Township, he and his family have been members of St. Vincent DePaul Parish in Richboro. He attended and graduated from Council Rock High School. When I invited Bishop Cooke to lead our Lenten Mission months ago, none of us, including himself, had any idea that he would become a bishop.

Currently, he resides at St. Charles Seminary, where he is the Dean of Formation. He has been working very closely the last few years in the preparation of men for the priesthood. He was a dean in fact for Fr. Ryan, as he prepared for ordination.

This is the latest in Lent that we have held a Mission, but I believe it helps us all to become spiritually prepared for Holy Week, which is only a week away. Bishop Cooke's theme for the Mission is **"A Meditation on the Sorrowful Mysteries of the Rosary."** It is certainly appropriate as we prepare during Holy Week to encounter once

again the passion, death and resurrection of Our Lord.

The Lenten Mission will also offer those who come yet another opportunity to prayerfully and honestly reflect on their lives, to make an honest Examination of Conscience, and then to encounter Jesus' mercy in the Sacrament of Reconciliation. Confessions will be heard after the 7:00pm Mission service on Sunday and Monday evenings.

Part of the life of every Christian is a constant willingness to repent. To turn and return to God's mercy. I sometimes hear people say, "Why go to confession? I just fall into the same sin, unfortunately, again." I respond, "Welcome to the human race. If God's mercy had a limit, we would all be in trouble." The good news is His mercy endures forever.

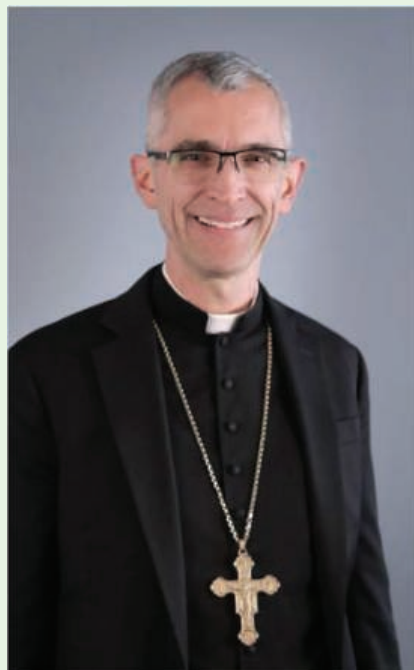

Bishop Cooke joined the faculty at St. Charles Borromeo Seminary in June 2013, and currently serves as the Dean of Men for the Theology Seminary. From 2013 to 2021, he was Director of the Spiritual Year program. He also serves on the Theology formation team. Pope Francis appointed Cooke, along with Fr. Keith J. Chylinski and Fr. Efren V. Esmilla, to be Auxiliary Bishops for Philadelphia on Dec. 8, 2023.

Since Archbishop Nelson J. Pérez performed the Episcopal Ordination of the three Bishops on March 7, 2024, at the Cathedral Basilica of Saints Peter and Paul in Philadelphia, this will be the first Parish Mission for Bishop Cooke!

He began his priestly formation at Saint Charles Borromeo Seminary and earned master's degrees in 2005 and 2006, and was ordained to the priesthood on May 20, 2006.

Previously Bishop Cooke served in the parishes of St. Eleanor, Collegeville; St. Martin of Tours, Philadelphia., and St. Francis of Assisi parish, Norristown. His home parish is St. Vincent de Paul in Richboro.

Dear Missionary Disciples,

May your fifth week of Lent be inspiring! One more week until Holy Week! The Patron Saint of Ireland is beloved by around the world as so many dress up in green and celebrate his

Feast Day. There is much writing about his life but most of it is hagiographic, a form of religious writing that at times is overly generous in its description of the lives of the Saints. There are two writings that are attributed to St. Patrick, his Confession and his letter to Coroticus. They are great reads for giving insight into St. Patrick and the Catholic faith at the time in the 4th Century.

St. Patrick's Confession is St. Patrick's response to accusations set against him by his brother priests. It gives much insight to the suffering he endured as a slave in Ireland before escaping to return to Ireland and become a priest. In the end, God called St. Patrick back to Ireland to preach the Gospel and be a fisher of men: "For that reason, therefore, we ought to fish well and diligently, as the Lord exhorts in advance and teaches, saying: Come you after me, and I will make you to be fishers of men" (St. Patrick's Confession-paragraph 40). This is our baptismal call that is renewed in our Lenten journey to Easter to spread the good news and become fishers of men. St. Patrick pray for us today for strength in our Lenten journey and the fulfillment of our Easter promises.

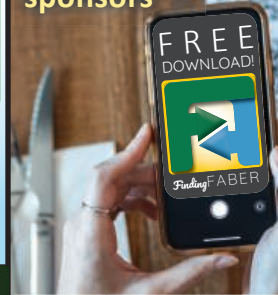

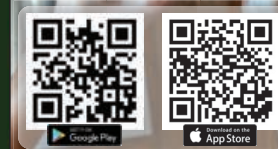
