## A MESSAGE FROM YOUR PASTOR

My dear parishioners,

Last Monday, most Americans were captivated as they watched the historic total solar eclipse, that won't happen again in our area for several years. Visibility unfortunately due to cloud cover in our area, was not so good. And so I chose to watch it on television. It was amazing to watch it happen, little by little, across the U.S.A.

I'm not sure what was more fascinating. Of course, the sky suddenly going dark was surreal. But how about the birds suddenly confused and flying in all different directions! And that beautiful corona of light around the darkened disk, which was the moon.

For me, what was truly encouraging to see was all the people gathering together in cities across the country. News reporters from the different networks kept saying the same thing: Isn't this wonderful that for at least a few hours, the people of this country who are so divided politically can put aside their differences and marvel together, side by side, at this amazing moment.

The reporters kept saying too how when you see the eclipse, you can't help but be in awe at the beauty and order of the universe. And you realize again something that we forget: namely that we are fellow citizens on this tiny planet, in this vast universe. While I was disappointed that none of them said, "Only a Supreme Being could have created this," nonetheless I was encouraged when many said that we have a common bond that we often forget. We emphasize our differences, and the eclipse reminded us that we are a family.

In 2017, Pope Francis gave a speech on social media. Its theme was entitled, "The Future You." He emphasized the interconnectedness of all humanity, regardless of our race, culture, religion, citizenship or political party. The Pope reminded the world that our actions and choices have consequences that ripple throughout this planet. Francis called for, "A revolution of tenderness, marked by humility, solidarity, and encounter."

Pope Francis quoted the famous verse in the Gospel of St. John that, "God so loved the world that He sent His Only Son so that we may have eternal life." Think of that... God looked down on this tiny speck in the universe, filled as it always is with division and



enmity, and still found something valuable in us, to send us His Son.

As we enter these coming months of political campaigns and rhetoric, let us not forget the lesson of the eclipse – that we are fellow citizens of this world. May the "future you" and me be led by the revolution of tenderness and solidarity which Christ proclaimed and lived, if we hope to survive.
