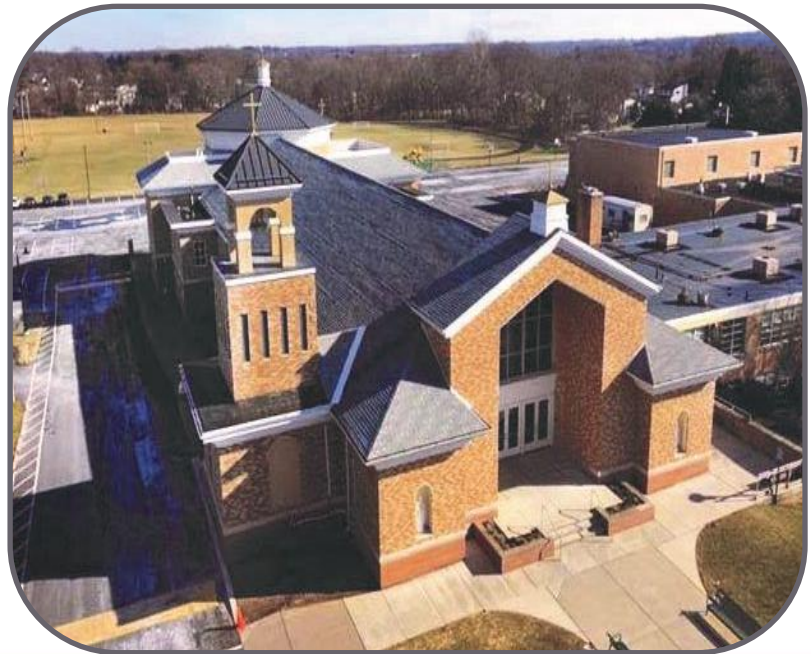

Marriage - Saturday weddings are 10:00AM, 12:00 Noon, & 2:00 PM. It is Diocesan policy that arrangements must be made AT LEAST 6 MONTHS prior to the wedding. Information on Marriage Instructions can be obtained from the priests. For information on music, call Susan DiFlorio at 215-891-0869.

Anointing of the Sick - In case of serious illness (or advanced age), please call the priests.

Hospital cases should contact the Chaplain, but the Parish Office should be notified so one of the priests may visit the patient.

A MESSAGE FROM YOUR PASTOR

My dear parishioners,

One of the most cherished things that I get to do as a priest is celebrate First Holy Communion for our children. Their excitement for this special moment in their lives brings back beautiful memories of my own First Communion, as I'm sure it does for

you.

We can all remember the feeling of anticipation, knowing that Jesus Himself would become a guest in our hearts for the first time. Here at St. Bede we make this celebration of First Holy Communion a very solemn and joyous occasion. Each child walks up the steps of the sanctuary, flanked by their parents. The child kneels at a beautifully adorned white kneeler. An altar server holds a candle as a reminder of the First Communicant's baptism, when he or she first became a child of God.

I mention this because the celebration of First Holy Communion should give us all a pause to recall our own First Communion, and the fervor and joy with which we received Jesus for the first time. During this three-year revival of belief in the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist, it is important to note that when we do something so often, we can tend to forget its meaning.

On this First Communion weekend, let us remember that **what we receive in Holy Eucharist is not a thing, but a Person.** And that Person is the Son of God. The same Jesus whose Head rested on hay in the manger; the same Jesus who cured a leper; the same Jesus who died on the cross and rose from the dead, is the same Jesus who comes into your heart and mine at Holy Communion.

When we truly realize that we would never want to absent ourselves from this opportunity or any opportunity to receive Him. Each week has its own set of joys and sorrows, for which we need Jesus to accompany us. I don't know about you, but I cannot imagine life without knowing Jesus is beside me and in me and all through me.

Every time I really concentrate on the Eucharist I keep recalling the words that St. Elizabeth said to Mary at the Visitation upon Mary's arrival, *"But who am I that the mother of my Lord should come to me?"*

Yes, who are we that God would lower Himself to come into our hearts each time we receive Him in the Eucharist? He sees something in us so valuable that at time we fail to see. "Jesus, as You come to our First Communicants, and to us in Holy Communion, make us like You: humble, loving, forgiving, and pure."

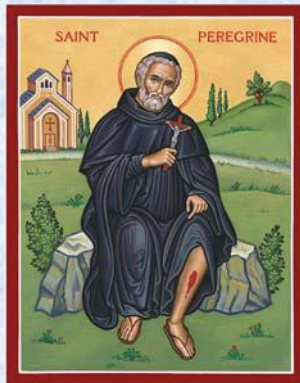

The Amen app is available for download at the Apple app store, or at the Google Play store.

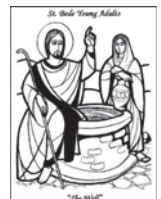
