### A MESSAGE FROM YOUR PASTOR

My dear parishioners,

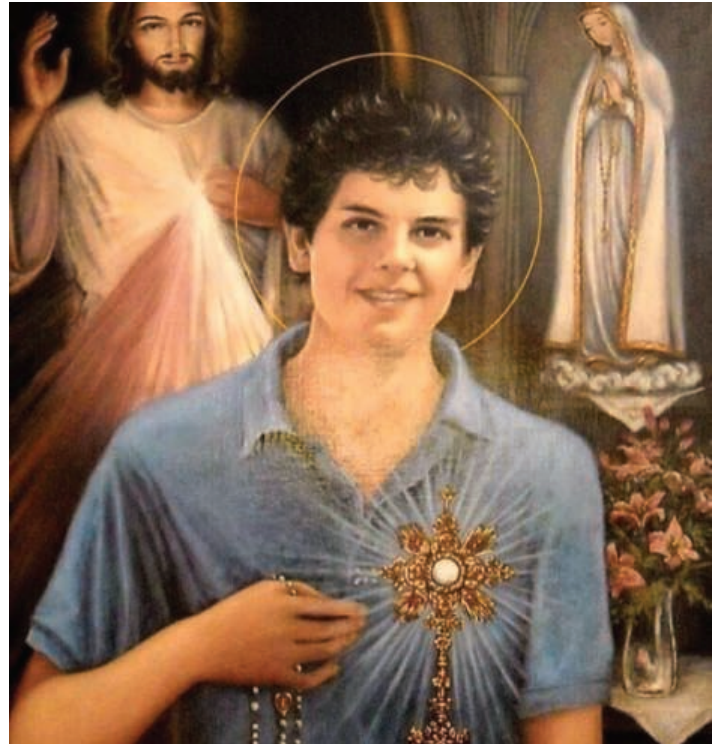
This weekend we celebrate the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ. Someone might say, "Well, isn't every Sunday a celebration of the Body and Blood of Christ? Isn't every weekday Mass, every funeral or wedding Mass in essence, the same thing?"

Of course it is! But like everything else in life it is important for us to shine the spotlight on something so special, which we celebrate so often, because it can easily be taken for granted. As a priest who celebrates Mass every day and who hears confessions very often, I can tell you how important it is for me, like every priest, to reflect for a few moments on what I'm about to do in those Sacraments. And how I am acting in the Person of Jesus.

Therefore, I must remember that I am not just a functionary, but about to be a celebrant of Christ's Presence in the Eucharist. Why? Because saying the words, "This is My Body" actually makes Jesus Present in that piece of bread. My saying, "I absolve you from your sins" actually makes Jesus present to forgive the sinner. Reminding myself of what I am about to do is important because it can be taken for granted. Sometimes I wonder if, after seeing seven or eight of Jesus' miracles, did the apostles begin to lose their sense of awe? It can happen.

On the Feast of Corpus Christi we are reminded that coming to Mass and receiving our Lord Jesus is the most important thing you and I will do the entire week. If we really and truly believe that Jesus is Present, Body and Soul and Divinity in the Eucharist, and that we encounter the same Jesus the apostles and the people who went to Him for cures encountered, we will never want to miss Mass, unless it is a very, very good reason.

We live in a time of doubt. Statistics say that either people do not know that the Eucharist is truly Jesus, or they doubt that it could be true. "Why would God do such a thing?" they ask. I think the recent news of the miracle



attributed to **Blessed Carlo Acutis** (above) that was recognized recently by Pope Francis (which will soon lead to his canonization), will help all those that doubt. Blessed Carlo Acutis will soon be the first saint from the millennial generation.

There were many of Carlos' contemporaries who doubted in the Real Presence of the Eucharist. So Carlo, being very proficient in computers and social media technology, took it upon himself to catalogue on his personal website all of the Eucharistic miracles that have taken place throughout the centuries, up to the present time. His good work, which can be even accessed now online, has brought many people back to faith in the Real Presence. His example lights the path for all of us to encounter the wonderful gift that we can take for granted – Jesus, Present in the Most Holy Eucharist.

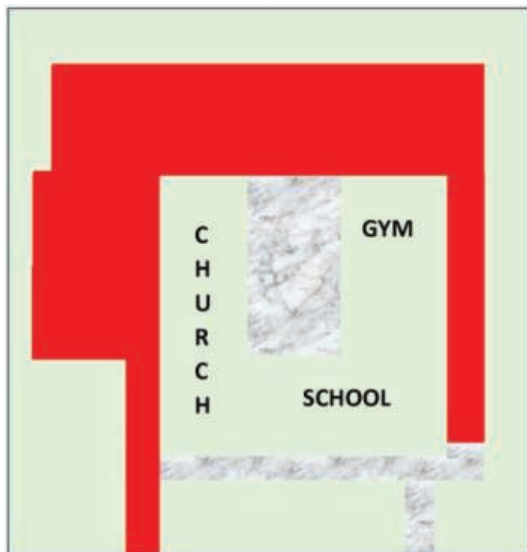

Happy June! June is the month of the Sacred Heart. May you be blessed by the Sacred Heart of Jesus this month! The Heart that gave all at the Cross was pierced and poured out blood and water. This is the Blood and Water of His Divine Mercy. "The purpose of devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus is to

## Cornerstone for Life

### Catholic Bishops Oppose S. Dakota Amendment Legalizing Abortions up to Birth

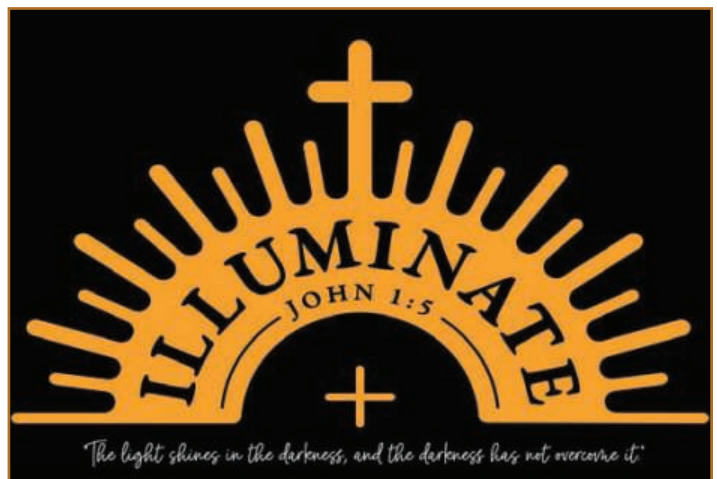
"On May 16, 2024, the South Dakota Secretary of State certified for the November 5, 2024 election ballot a proposed constitutional amendment that would legalize abortion through all nine months of pregnancy. The Secretary has designated the proposal as Amendment G.

This amendment would overturn dozens of pro-life laws in South Dakota that protect preborn children and their mothers from the dangers of abortion. The certification decision may be challenged in court due to irregularities in the petition circulation process, some of which were previously identified by the state attorney general. If a legal challenge ensues, we should pray that it results in the removal of this extreme measure from the ballot, given the threat it poses to South Dakota's most vulnerable citizens.

However, given the inherent uncertainties surrounding any litigation, prudence requires us to prepare for the scenario that Amendment G will be decided by voters in the November 5 election. We urge Catholics and all people of good will to study this measure carefully, understand the devastating consequences it would have for our state, and work with great determination to ensure this measure does not become a part of our state's constitution.

During the nearly 50 years that *Roe v. Wade* was in effect, an estimated 46,000 preborn girls and boys perished from abortion in our state. This scourge came to an end on June 24, 2022, when the U.S. Supreme Court handed down the *Dobbs* decision, finally allowing South Dakota to enforce laws that protect the human rights of preborn children.

Amendment G would reverse all this progress and create a regime of unrestricted abortion that would be far worse even than what was in effect under *Roe*. Amendment G would not even permit health and safety regulations for most abortions."

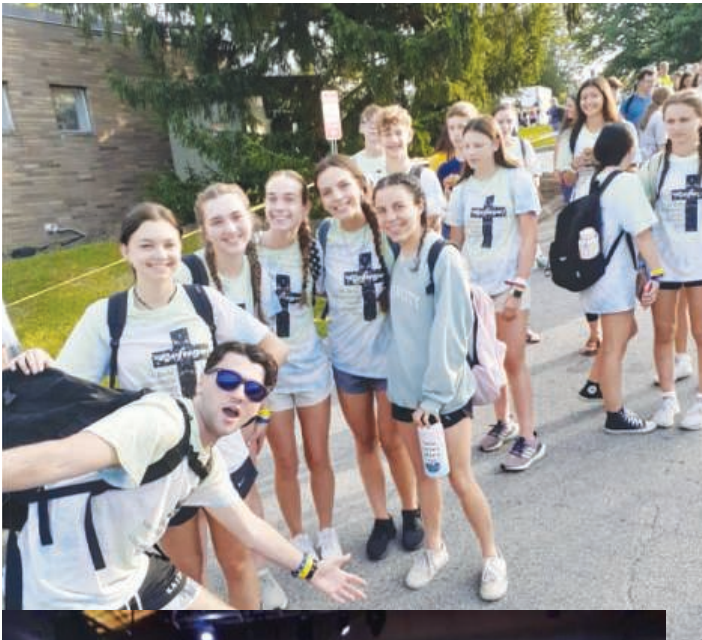
