Marriage - Saturday weddings are 10:00AM, 12:00 Noon, & 2:00 PM. It is Diocesan policy that arrangements must be made AT LEAST 6 MONTHS prior to the wedding. Information on Marriage Instructions can be obtained from the priests. For information on music, call Susan DiFlorio at 215-891-0869.

Anointing of the Sick - In case of serious illness (or advanced age), please call the priests.

Hospital cases should contact the Chaplain, but the Parish Office should be notified so one of the priests may visit the patient.

My dear parishioners,

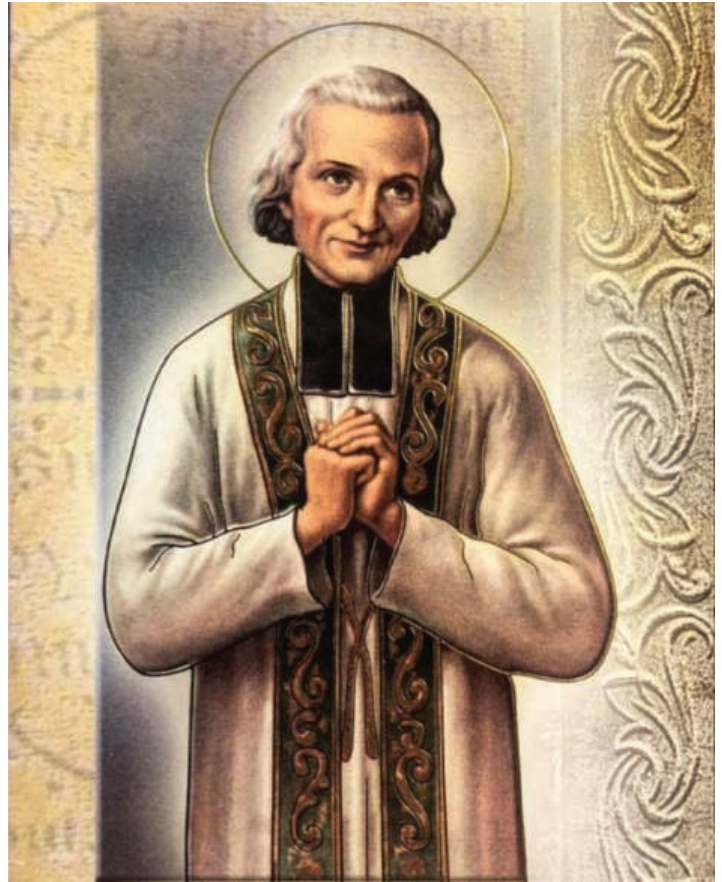
As I write this column, I realize that it is the eve of my 48th anniversary of ordination to the priesthood in the Cathedral Basilica of Saints Peter and Paul in Philadelphia on May 15, 1976. Like all of us when we celebrate a milestone, I ask, "Where did those 48 years go?"

The eight years of study and formation at St. Charles Seminary seemed to go by slowly. But from the time I carried in my bags and boxes with my father to my first assignment at St. Thomas Aquinas Parish in South Philly to the present, it has been a whirlwind of activity. But so exciting and fulfilling.

Whether it was serving as a Parochial Vicar in several parishes, as Chaplain at St. Agnes Hospital, Dean of Students at St. Charles Seminary, Episcopal Vicar for Montgomery County and now for the last 19 years as your pastor, I have met countless people who have touched and blessed my life. Hopefully I have touched their lives with the love of Jesus Christ. A priest is called to bridge the gap between God and humanity. I, like all priests, am humbled that I was chosen to follow such a rewarding life.

Well, I am not the only one celebrating an anniversary. Father Ryan celebrates his second anniversary on May 21, and Archbishop Adams celebrated his 54th anniversary on May 16. And what also makes this time of year so special is the ordination of three new priests for our Archdiocese, which took place this weekend at the Cathedral. As we ask your prayers for our anniversaries, we also ask you to pray for the newly ordained **Fathers Gregory Miller, Brendan Zehner and Bernard Ekeagwu**. While it is only three ordained this year, they are quality young priests who will be a blessing to the people they will be assigned to serve.

St. John Vianney, who is the Patron Saint of parish priests, once said, "The priesthood is the love of the Heart of our Lord, Jesus Christ." As priests, that is our mandate. That is our goal. And that is what we will be judged on by God when we meet him at our passing. It's a tall order for sure. And that is why we rely on your prayers, your



support, and above all, your example. For if we are the Heart of the love of Jesus to you, you are the Face of Jesus to us.

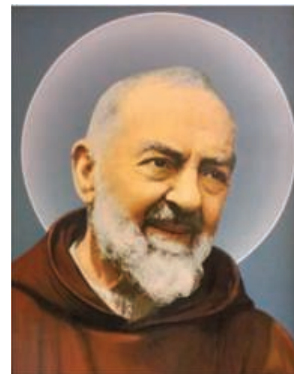

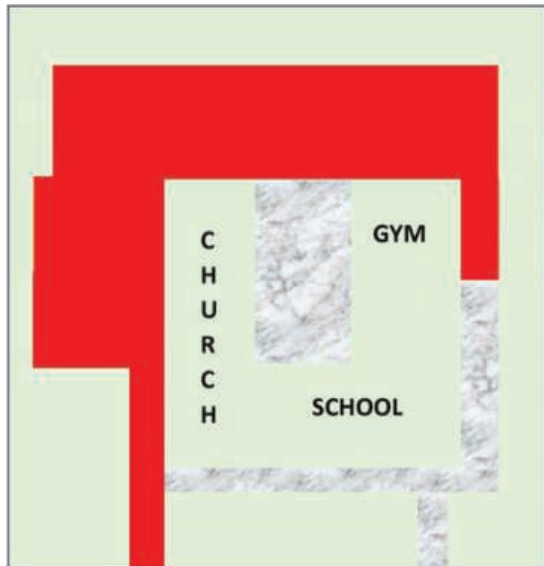
