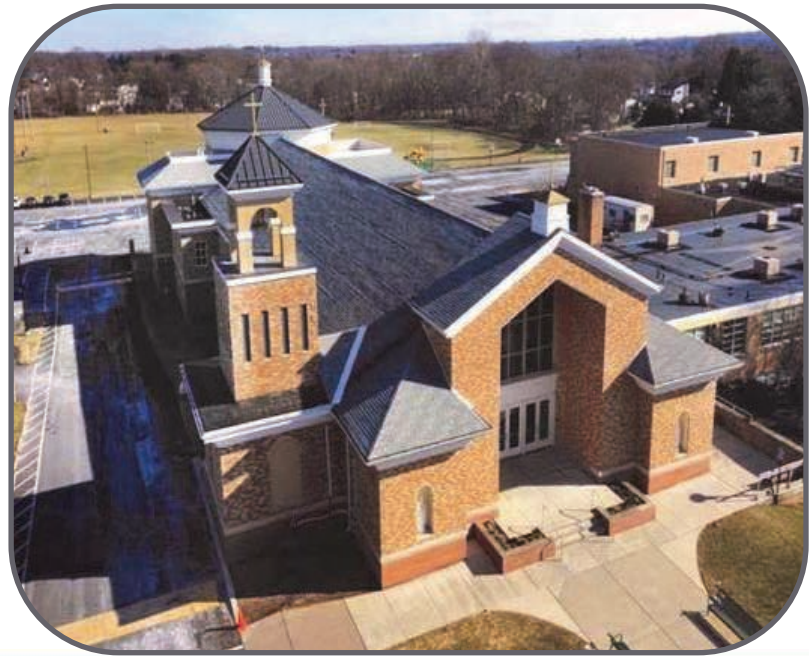

My dear parishioners,

You may have noticed the announcement in the bulletin over the past few weeks, regarding the start of the **Dementia Support Group for Caregivers** of Loved Ones suffering with this condition. I am familiar and sensitive to the challenges experienced by all involved, since a very close and dear uncle of mine suffered from

dementia. And my aunt, who was the principal caregiver, endured a great amount of suffering along with him. She and her children could have benefitted from such a support group, but none was available at that time. Recently a woman from St. Bede whose husband has been diagnosed with dementia asked our Pastoral Council and me to consider the possibility of St. Bede Parish offering a support group for caregivers. With the advice of our Pastoral Council, I asked **Kris Ingle** our Parish Outreach Coordinator to begin the process of initiating such a group.

It was only a week later when Kris identified **Charissa Bermingham**, one of our parishioners whose previous employment was with dementia patients and their caregiving families. I'm always amazed how God opens doors when we need His assistance, and likewise how many talented people we have in our midst who respond so quickly when there is a need.

The first support group meeting for dementia caregivers will take place on **Thursday May 2, 2024 in the St. Francis Center**, on our St. Bede campus. For more information please contact Parish Nurse Kris Ingle at **215-357-4113**.

On another completely different topic, I want to express my gratitude to all those who have already contributed to

our Capital Campaign for what will be a newly constructed parking lot. At the time of the publication of this bulletin, we have achieved **57 percent of our goal** to raise \$500,000.00. I am amazed and delighted that we are at this point in the Campaign, given the fact that we just started a month ago.

If you are like me, when I receive campaign literature, I put it on a stack of other mail and say, "I will get to it." I usually need some kind of reminder to get going and make my charitable contribution. For this reason I ask you to consider your gift to the Campaign, so we can stay on our timetable, which will allow construction to take place this summer. In time for all the parish activities which resume and take place in September, most especially school, religious education, and CYO.

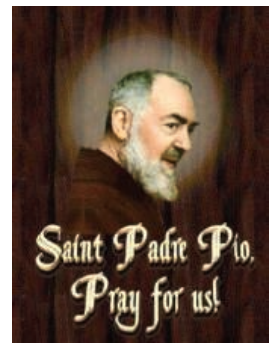

Catholic Home Missions Collection May 4-5, 2024

Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

Home Mission dioceses are often impoverished and have small or widely dispersed Catholic populations that stretch over vast areas of terrain. These economic, demographic, and geographic challenges make it difficult for the Church to minister to the needs of Her people in those regions. In addition, the populations of Home Mission dioceses are disproportionately impacted by unemployment, natural

disasters, and crime rates.

In the Diocese of Amarillo, for example, the diocesan criminal justice ministry answers Christ's call to visit and serve prisoners and patients confined to hospitals. Since 2004, this ministry has expanded to bring the Eucharist, Sacred Scripture, and prayer to inmates of the seven prisons and two large hospitals in the diocese. This ministry of mercy includes retreats during which inmates can encounter the love of Jesus, heal from past failures and wounds, and develop new hope for the future. Many inmates have experienced spiritual conversions that have inspired them to join formation programs and enter the Catholic Church.

The criminal justice ministry is one of many innovative outreach efforts made by dioceses supported by Catholic Home Missions. Your participation in the annual Catholic Home Missions Appeal supports dioceses throughout the United States and its territories that need financial help to sustain core pastoral services and missions of mercy to those they serve. 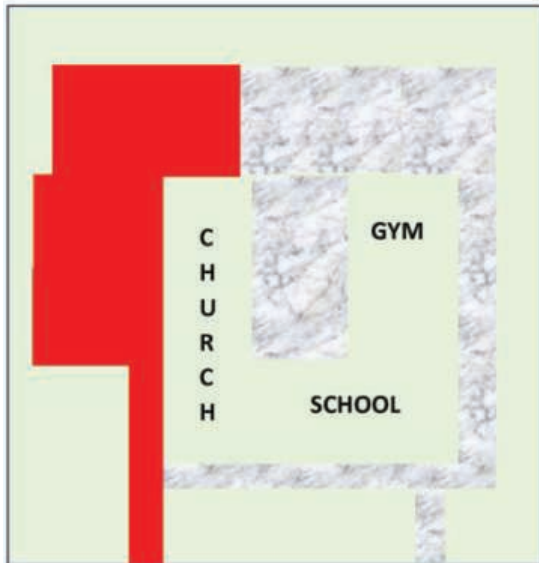

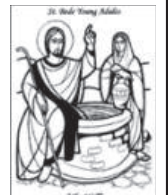

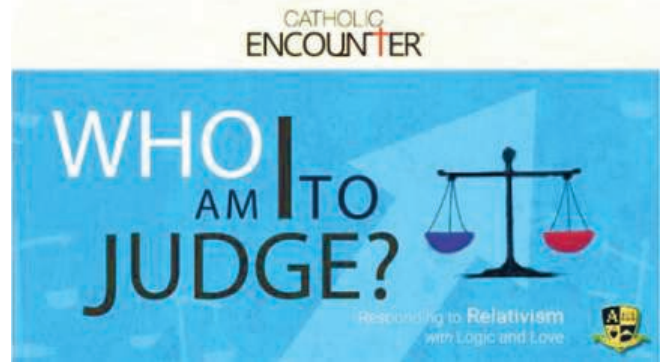

Data Breakdown: Abortion pill regimen accounts for 63% of all abortions

The latest data on abortion is in from the Guttmacher Institute, and the results are sobering. Nationwide, abortions have risen TEN PERCENT since 2020, with 63 percent of all abortions now done via the abortion pill regimen. The last time data was collected, the abortion pill regimen accounted for 53 percent of all abortions. The new data shows a 10 percent jump.

The tireless crusade of the abortion industry has worked hard over the last year, giving us the highest abortion numbers on record since 2011.

The rise in abortion is not because of a sudden need for abortion, it is because there are people who disguise abortion as women’s healthcare and convince generations of women to kill their children, only to leave them alone to pick up the pieces.

We must embrace that God is a part of this fight. We must pray for our nation, for young mothers and fathers. We must pray for the safety of children, born and preborn. Prayer is our best defense against the evil which seeks to destroy human life. Maybe God is asking us to humble ourselves and recognize that we cannot do this alone. Have we really done that well on our own? Not according to these numbers. It is time we humble ourselves and pray. The power of prayer is immeasurable. Don’t think of it in terms of “All I can do is pray.” Switch your mindset to “The BEST thing I can do is pray.” Pray for an end to abortion and for the protection of the family!

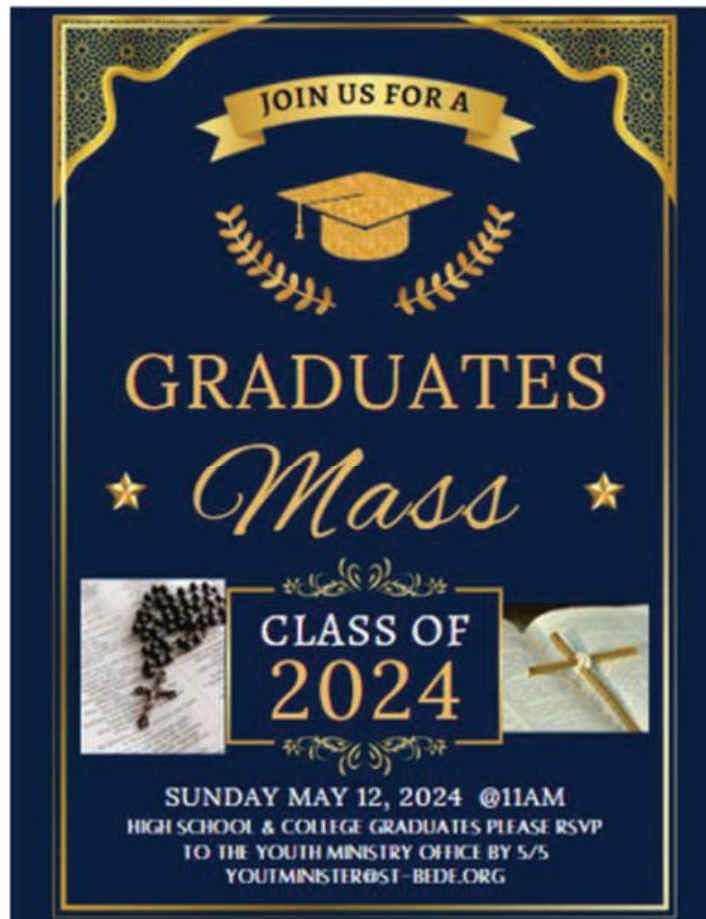

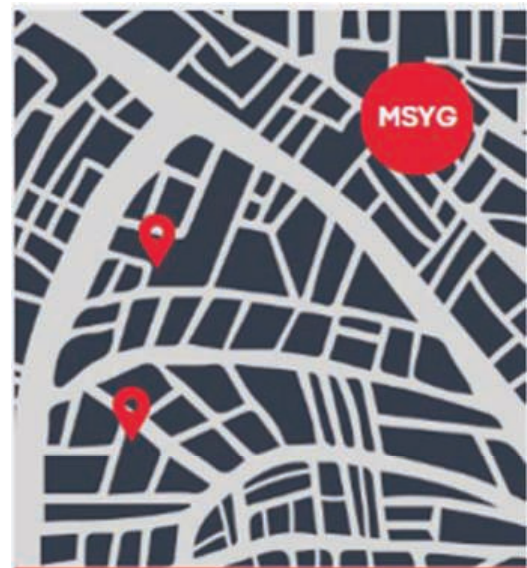

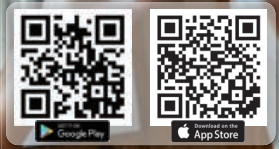
