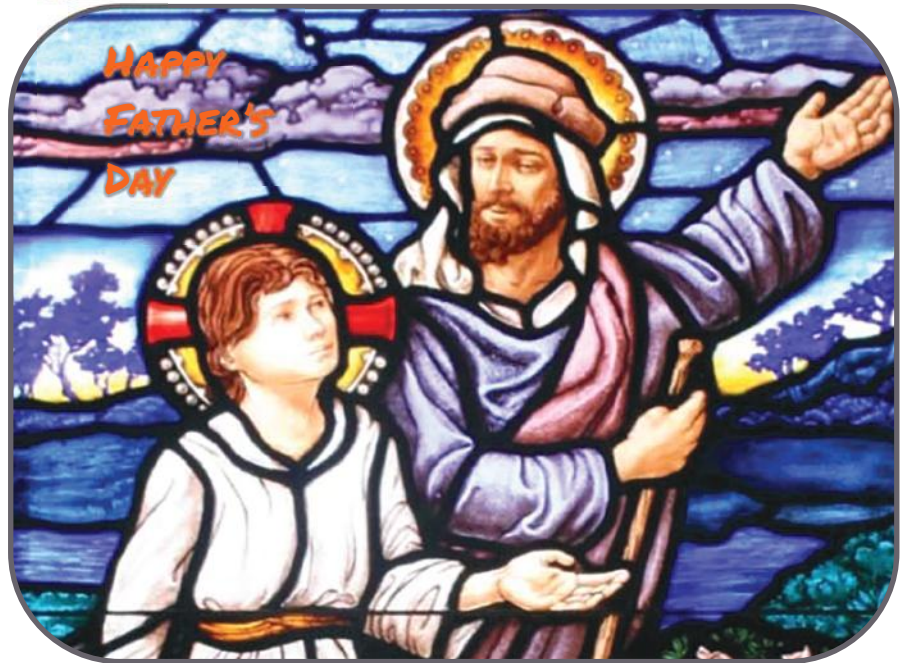

Anointing of the Sick - In case of serious illness (or advanced age), please call the priests.

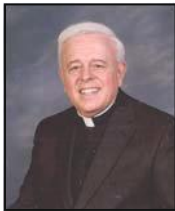

A MESSAGE FROM YOUR PASTOR

My dear parishioners,

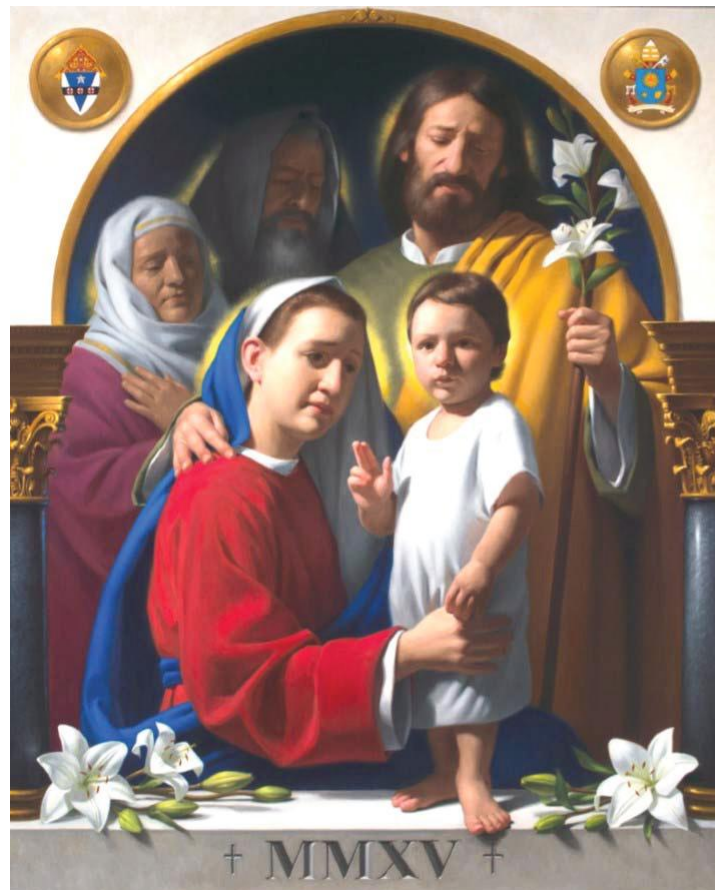
You probably have noticed by now that the vestments of the priests have changed back to green, which signals that we have returned to what the Catholic Church calls, "Ordinary Time" This week, in fact, is called "The 11th Sunday in Ordinary Time."

Ordinary Time is called "ordinary" not because it is common, but simply because the weeks of Ordinary Time are numbered. Thus the numbered weeks of this liturgical season in fact represent the ordered life of the Church. The period in which we live our lives, neither in feasting as in Christmas and Easter, or in more severe penance, as in Advent and Lent. But in watchfulness and expectation of the second coming of Christ.

Thus for Catholics, Ordinary Time is that part of the year in which Christ, the Lamb of God, walks among us and transforms our lives. There is nothing ordinary about that!

Likewise, the normal liturgical color for Ordinary Time, for days when there is no special feast, is green. However, during Ordinary Time, there are feasts of famous saints and of Mary, when the occasion calls for the liturgical color of white. Likewise, there are feasts of saints and apostles who were martyred, which calls for the wearing of red, the color of the blood they shed for Jesus Christ.

Green vestments on white altar cloths decorated in green have traditionally been associated with the time after Pentecost, a period in which the Church, founded by Jesus Christ and enlightened by the Holy Spirit, began to grow like green fields, and to spread the Gospel to all nations. Green is also associated with the virtue of hope. For in Ordinary Time, we pray and hope for the coming of our Savior, Jesus Christ.

And so, enjoy Ordinary Time! May it be a season of spiritual growth for you and me, and our relationship with Jesus Christ.

Finally, today is certainly not an ordinary Sunday for today we honor our fathers on Father's Day. We thank them for their leadership, strength and providential care. Even Jesus had a foster father on earth. St. Joseph, foster father of Jesus, pray for our fathers, living and deceased.

Cornerstone for Life

South Carolina Judge Upholds State's Heartbeat Law

South Carolina 5th Circuit Court Judge Daniel Coble upheld the Fetal Heartbeat and Protection from Abortion Act, dealing Planned Parenthood, the state's largest abortion business, a solid defeat.

"This Court," he wrote, "will never supplement the will of the General Assembly with its own interpretation because it would be a direct violation of the Constitution and the sacrosanct doctrine of the separation of powers."

"[I]t is clear beyond a shadow of a doubt," Judge Coble wrote, "that the General Assembly intended, and the public understood, that the time frame of the Act would begin around the six-week mark." Planned Parenthood argued in its latest lawsuit that its abortion business has declined by 75 percent in South Carolina as a result of the Fetal Heartbeat Act. It argued that the fetal heart is not developed until the ninth week of the baby's life and therefore the killing of unborn children should be legal until that point.

Lisa Van Riper, President of South Carolina Citizens for Life, commended Judge Coble's "thorough analysis of legislative intent." She said, "His understanding of the Rule of Law is in keeping with the judicial philosophy of strict constructionist judges who understand the separation of powers of the three branches of government."

Judge Coble cited 20 documented instances of the South Carolina General Assembly's understanding that the fetal heartbeat can be detected at least by the sixth week of the baby's life, and 60 instances of the State Supreme Court and circuit courts referring to the fetal heartbeat law as a six-week limit that protects the unborn with a beating heart from death by abortion.

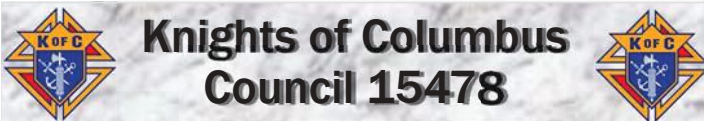

Pro-Life Mass & Rally for Life Saturday, June 22, 2024

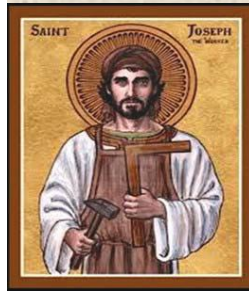

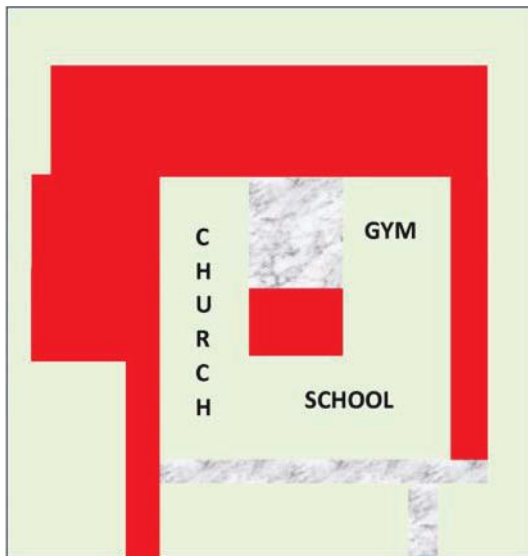

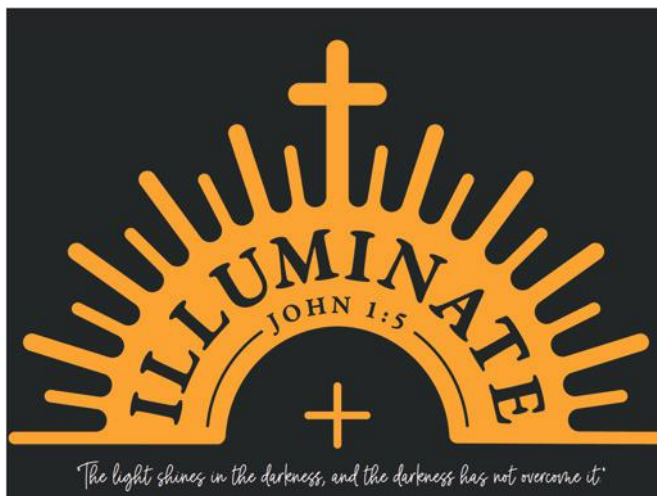
