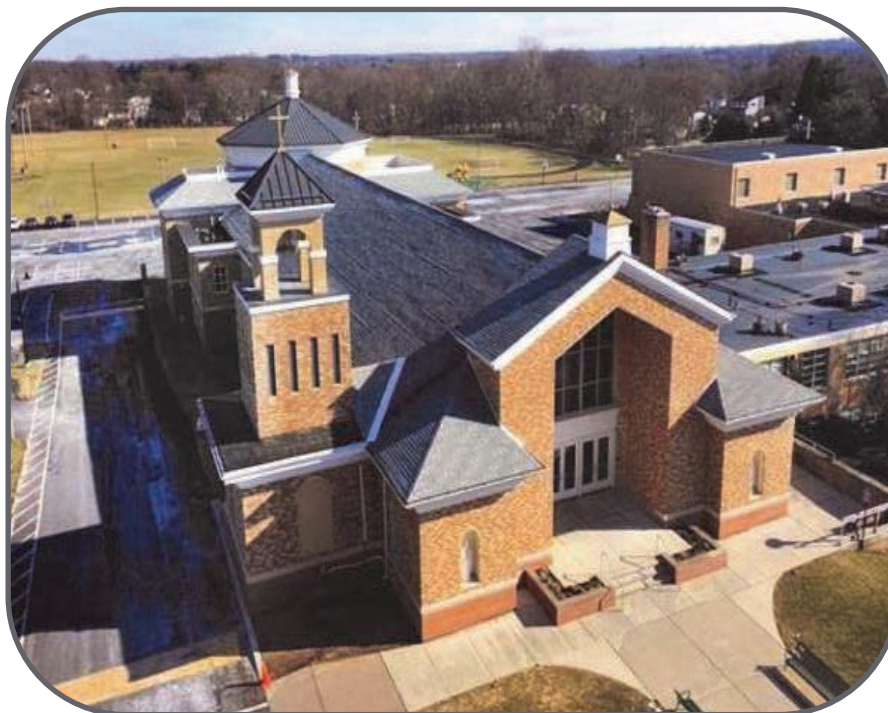

A MESSAGE FROM YOUR PASTOR

My dear parishioners,

This weekend we welcome **Fr. John Tawan MSC**, who is here at St. Bede to preach at all of our Masses as part of the annual **Missionary Cooperative Appeal**.

This appeal happens during the summer months of the year. Fr. Tawan will help to inform us about the missionary nature of the Church, and the important role the Missionaries of the Sacred Heart have in this work.

The Missionary Cooperative Appeal has a two-fold purpose. For one, it give the Catholic people of the USA an opportunity to "stretch our horizons," so to speak. To find out what's going on in different parts of the Catholic Church in its mission to evangelize the Gospel to every corner of the world. We get to see how the command of Jesus to His first apostles to "Go forward to all nations and baptize them in the name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit" is actually happening.

Each year a different religious community with its own particular charism is sent by the local Diocesan Office of

In our case, I am blessed to have Fr. Zehner and Archbishop Adams, so we do not need the missionary's help in that regard. But having him here helps us as priests to hear, along with you, the great stories of these modern-day missionaries, and the heroic works these brothers and priests are doing.

I join you in welcoming Fr. Tawan to St. Bede, and encourage you, as your means allow, to support their good works.

Dear Missionary Disciples,

August is a powerhouse of saints. We have St. Maximilian Kolbe on the 14th, the Assumption of Our Lady on August 15th, Our Lady of Knock on August 17th, the Queenship of Mary on August 22nd and St. Augustine on 28th.

Story of Our Lady: The story of Our Lady of Knock is one not only for the Irish but the whole world. It was 1879 and the people of Central/West Ireland (County Mayo) were going through another famine, but not as horrible as the first one in the 1840s, as the Irish called it the Great Hunger. In the little village of Knock, Our Lady, St. Joseph, St. John the Evangelist and Jesus, as the Lamb of God on the altar came to all who were at the church to see the marvelous visions. The witnesses themselves described what happened on the Vigil of the Queenship of Mary on August 21st, 1879. The vision came in silence in the pouring rain to 22 villagers of all ages but in the end only 15 came forward as official witnesses. It is a story of our ultimate hope as

OCIA STORIES OF FAITH

O.C.I.A. Stories of Faith is an outreach of St. Bede the Venerable to open the doors to the Catholic Church by explaining the O.C.I.A. process to our community and spreading the stories of our parish members who have participated in the program here or as part of their own personal faith journey into full communion with the Catholic Church.

What is O.C.I.A.? (Previously named R.C.I.A.)

O. C. I. A. stands for the Order of the Christian Initiation of Adults. The USCCB changed the name from R.C.I.A. (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults) to OCIA to better represent the Latin name (*Ordo Initiationis Christianae Adultorum*) and the new curriculum approved in 2022. OCIA is the process established by the universal Church for individuals to become Catholic and receive the sacraments of initiation-Baptism, Confirmation and the Eucharist. This initiation process involves a parish community experiencing a renewal of faith as it prepares and welcomes new members into the Church. The Order speaks of conversion as a "spiritual journey." St. Bede's 2024 O.C.I.A. program runs from September 19 to May 1 on Thursday nights at 7:00 pm in the Drexel Center.

Who is O.C.I.A. for? (Previously named R.C.I.A.)

1. Persons interested in exploring the Catholic faith;
2. Persons in need of Baptism;
3. Persons baptized in another Christian tradition who desire to become Catholic; and
4. Persons baptized Catholic in need of First Communion and/or Confirmation.

process?

Was there any point of the process that you found helpful?

Absolutely! I learned so much about what the Catholic faith actually is and not what I thought it was. The truths, history and meaning behind the traditions and sacraments really helped connect the dots for me. I'm grateful for the wonderful teachers and parishioners who dedicated themselves to help the class grow spiritually.

What would you tell someone who might be inquiring about the Catholic faith or the OCIA Process?

Don't hesitate! It's the most important decision you will ever make.

How has the OCIA program helped you understand your faith and grow closer to God?

It's helped me understand the way God worked in my life as a person, father, husband and leader. The revelation I got helped me see more clearly in my own spirituality. The awesome history and tradition of the Catholic faith taught me the magnitude of God's church and how awesome he is.

How do you plan to live out your faith going forward?

I plan to pray, live out the sacraments and scripture. With God's help and direction, I will continue to try to be the best husband and father I can be.

What is your favorite story in the Bible or about the Catholic faith?

Too many to list, but one that resonates with me is the story of Jacob as he wrestled with God. Ultimately, God had to break him into submission. I see myself in this story, and I now see that God loves me and he wants me even if I choose to wrestle (which I have)!

If you were to write a story about your faith journey what would be the title of your story? The struggle is real and so is the faith.

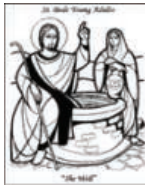

Tell Congress: Tiny Newborn Lives are at Stake

Proposals in Congress threaten human life, the family, and religious freedom. The need to accompany and support the increasing number of families struggling with infertility is real. But members of Congress – including many who consider themselves pro-life – are in a rush to promote access to a new national “right” to in vitro fertilization (IVF) and other such technologies that destroy preborn human lives and treat people like property (like surrogacy, gene editing, and cloning). Some of the current proposals would also threaten Catholic hospitals, charities, schools, and other organizations and people that do not enable or cover these medical procedures. They could even allow minors to receive the procedures despite parents’ objections. 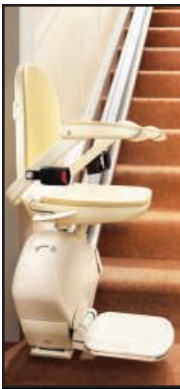
