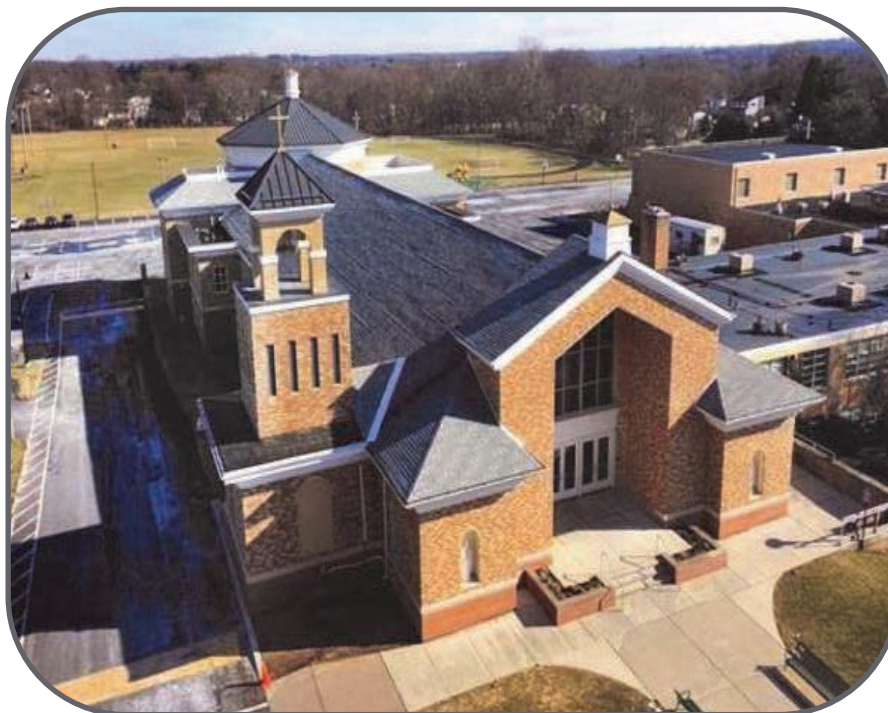

A MESSAGE FROM YOUR PASTOR

My dear parishioners,

I am pleased to announce that we have reached **90 percent of our “Pave the Way” Capital Campaign goal**, which now enables us to proceed with the project! Thank you to all who have contributed so generously, both in cash and pledged donations.

Those who have not yet contributed, I encourage you, if possible, to help us reach 100 percent.

Repaving of the entire parking lot will be done by Meco Constructors during the month of August. In fact, groundbreaking will take place this coming **Wednesday August 7, at 7:00am**. I offer the following information to all parishioners and visitors, since the construction will temporarily impact our lives:

- 1) Work on the Parking Lot will start on Wednesday August 7, weather permitting. It will be completed within 2 ½ to 3 weeks.
- 2) Paving will be done from 7:00am to around 3:00pm, Monday to Friday.
- 3) Work will be done in phases – there will always be a part of the parking lot that will be open.
- 4) Work will be planned to not interfere with the 9:00am Mass, and any funerals that may come up.
- 5) There will be access to all buildings (church, school, Drexel Center, Adoration Chapel) at all times. But not all entrances will be open, and there may be a distance from available parking.
- 6) There will be access to the soccer fields for evening practices and games.
- 7) Meco will provide regular scheduling information on which sections will be under construction.
- 8) Noise- Milling is very noisy. Meco will schedule to, as much as possible, avoid milling in the area around the day chapel or church during Daily Mass or funerals.
- 9) Please avoid the active construction areas! Meco will mark work areas with visible barrier installation and maintenance in the form of post stanchions and caution tape.
- 10) During much of the construction, parking spaces will not be marked. Please use extra caution when driving and parking especially for Weekend Masses.



Thank you for your patience and understanding during this very important project.

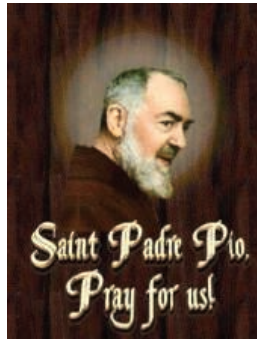

It is a year of pilgrimage, celebration and joy marked by the opening of the Holy Door in Rome at the Basilica

On the following Sunday, 29 December 2024, Pope Francis will open the door to his cathedral, Saint John Lateran. Then, on 1 January 2025, the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God, the Holy Door of the Papal Basilica of Saint Mary Major will be opened. Finally, Sunday, 5 January 2025, will mark the opening of the Holy Door of the Papal Basilica of Saint Paul Outside the Walls. On Sunday, 29 December 2024, in every cathedral and co-cathedral, diocesan bishops are to celebrate Holy Mass as the solemn opening of the Jubilee Year and open the Holy Door in all the other dioceses

the Papal Basilica of Saint Mary Major will be opened. Finally, Sunday, 5 January 2025, will mark the opening of the Holy Door of the Papal Basilica of Saint Paul Outside the Walls. On Sunday, 29 December 2024, in every cathedral and co-cathedral, diocesan bishops are to celebrate Holy Mass as the solemn opening of the Jubilee Year and open the Holy Door in all the other dioceses

Pope Francis has asked the Church to dedicate itself to prayer to prepare for the great Jubilee of Hope in 2025. OCIA STORIES OF FAITH

O.C.I.A. Stories of Faith is an outreach of St. Bede the Venerable to open the doors to the Catholic Church by explaining the O.C.I.A. process to our community and spreading the stories of our parish members who have participated in the program here or as part of their own personal faith journey into full communion with the Catholic Church.

What is O.C.I.A.? (Previously named R.C.I.A.)

O. C. I. A. stands for the Order of the Christian Initiation of Adults. The USCCB changed the name from R.C.I.A. (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults) to OCIA to better represent the Latin name (*Ordo Initiationis Christianae Adultorum*) and the new curriculum approved in 2022. OCIA is the process established by the universal Church for individuals to become Catholic and receive the sacraments of initiation-Baptism, Confirmation and the Eucharist. This initiation process involves a parish community experiencing a renewal of faith as it prepares and welcomes new members into the Church. The Order speaks of conversion as a "spiritual journey." St. Bede's 2024 O.C.I.A. program runs from September 19 to May 1 on Thursday nights at 7:00 pm in the Drexel Center.

Who is O.C.I.A. for? (Previously named R.C.I.A.)

1. Persons interested in exploring the Catholic faith;
2. Persons in need of Baptism;
3. Persons baptized in another Christian tradition who desire to become Catholic; and
4. Persons baptized Catholic in need of First Communion and/or Confirmation.

STORY OF FAITH- NANCY "ANN" STEZZI (ST. BEDE PARISHIONER)

Who or what led you to enter the OCIA process?

I had several things happen at once. First, I was regularly attending Mass at St. Bede with my family. Second, my son had a friend whose mom was in the choir. She found out from my son that I sang and she invited me to join the choir. I didn't need to be Catholic, so I joined. Being part of the Mass every Sunday and being part of the special liturgies and being embraced by such a loving, faith based group of people led me to loving the faith, too. And third, I grew in admiring my mother-in-law's deep faith. She never pressured me to convert. She just lived her Catholic faith every day and was an inspiring example of how I wanted to live my life. It just seemed like a natural progression to find out more about the Catholic faith, so I entered the RCIA program. **Was there any point of the process that you found helpful?**

It was all helpful. Getting all the basics of the Catholic faith, getting introduced to the history of the Catholic faith, having questions answered was all a very important part of the process. But the meaning of the Sacraments and the Eucharist were probably the highlight. **What would you tell someone who might be inquiring about the Catholic faith or the OCIA Process?**

Go for it!!! It just may change your life!
How has the OCIA program helped you understand your faith and grow closer to God?

It made me realize that "becoming Catholic" is a lifelong process. It doesn't end at the Easter Vigil-it's just the beginning. But it is something that has to be part of my life every day.

How do you plan to live out your faith going forward?

I am still active with the choir. And I am honored to be part of the Sunday Mass as a cantor. I was drawn to the Catholic faith through music so I feel I am continuing to live my faith through music. But another extremely important factor in growing my faith life has been being part of two Bible study groups. The first is the Tuesday Morning Bible Study. I started with Jeff Cavin's Bible Timeline. It changed my life. The Bible came alive for me. I encourage you to join the Tuesday morning Bible study! The second is the Wednesday morning Faith Enrichment group which is a prayerful discussion group of the next Sunday's Mass readings. All are welcome.

What is your favorite story in the Bible or about the Catholic faith?

I never get tired of the Prodigal son. Every time I hear it, I hear something new.

If you were to write a story about your faith journey what would be the title of your story?

"The Endless Journey-" The more I learn the more I want to know. And there is an endless amount to learn.

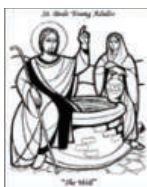

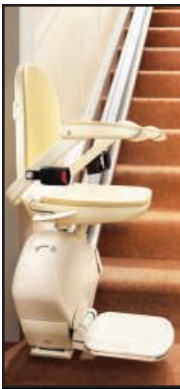
