Anointing of the Sick - In case of serious illness (or advanced age), please call the priests.

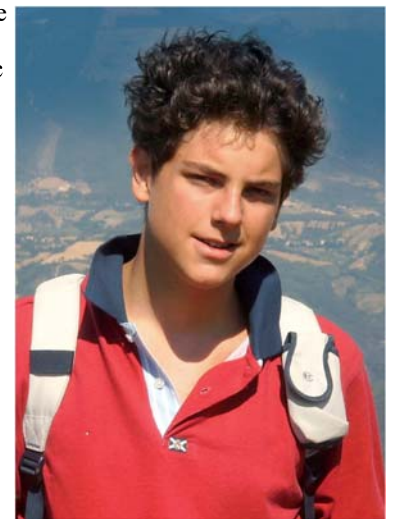

O.C.I.A.- STORIES OF FAITH

O.C.I.A Stories of Faith is an outreach of St. Bede the Venerable to open the doors to the Catholic Church by explaining the O.C.I.A process to our community and spreading the stories of our parish members who have participated in the program here or as part of their own personal faith journey into full communion with the Catholic Church.

What is O.C.I.A.? (Previously named R.C.I.A)

O. C. I. A. stands for the Order of the Christian Initiation of Adults. The USCCB changed the name from R.C.I.A. (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults) to OCIA to better represent the Latin name (*Ordo Initiationis Christianae Adultorum*) and the new curriculum approved in 2022. OCIA is the process established by the universal Church for individuals to become Catholic and receive the sacraments of initiation-Baptism, Confirmation and the Eucharist. This initiation process involves a parish community experiencing a renewal of faith as it prepares and welcomes new members into the Church. The Order speaks of conversion as a "spiritual journey." St. Bede's O.C.I.A. program runs from September 19 to May 1 on Thursday nights at 7:00 pm in the Drexel Center.

Who is O.C.I.A. for? (Previously named R.C.I.A)

1. Persons interesting in exploring and interested in the Catholic faith;
2. Persons in need of Baptism;
- 3) Persons baptized in another Christian tradition who desire to become Catholic; and
- 4) Persons baptized Catholic in need of First Communion and/or Confirmation.

The Ultimate Story of Faith

The ultimate story of faith is the story of a baby boy born in Bethlehem, in a manger. It is a story of a boy raised by his father and mother, Joseph and Mary. It is a story of a family and their son, a Jewish boy that becomes a man, yet not only a man, but the Savior of the World. "For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him might not perish but might have eternal life." (John 3:16). This is the story of Jesus, the story of the Christ who gave himself on the Cross so that you may be made whole, healed of your brokenness and be with God in heaven forever.
