A MESSAGE FROM YOUR PASTOR

My dear parishioners and pilgrims from far and wide,

Welcome to our **ninth annual Padre Pio Festival** weekend! While Padre Pio's feast is really September 23, our Festival here at St. Bede serves as a kick-off to the nine-day novena that leads up to that great day. Padre Pio is such a popular and well-known modern day saint, that it seems right to extend his feast as much as we can.

By the way, his feast day September 23 was the day when Padre Pio died and left this world for eternal life. But because there are so many miracles still occurring through his intercession, my belief is that he is somehow like a bridge between heaven and earth, still working hard to bring souls with him to paradise. And the mosaic on our bell tower, depicts this reality.

As a keepsake for this special weekend, I would like to provide you with a taste of some of Padre Pio's favorite

spiritual maxims that he shared with the thousands of people who wrote to him:

- ◆ *Pray, hope and don't worry.*
- ◆ *Prayer is the best armor we have. It is the key which opens the heart of God.*
- ◆ *Whoever does not meditate is like someone who never looks in the mirror before going out, doesn't bother to see if he's tidy. He may go out dirty without knowing it. The person who turns his mind to God who is the mirror of his soul, seeks to know his faults. Tries to correct them, moderates his impulses, and puts his conscience in order.*
- ◆ *The cross will not crush you. If its weight makes you stagger, its power will also sustain you.*
- ◆ *Let us climb Calvary without getting tired. Carrying our cross, and being certain that the climb will lead us to the beatific vision of our Savior.*
- ◆ *Bear in mind that the more the enemy assaults you, the closer God is to your soul. Think about and penetrate this great and confident truth.*
- ◆ *Even if you were to commit all the sins of the world, Jesus would repeat to you, "Many of your sins are forgiven because you have loved much."*
- ◆ *Recognize the devil is a real individual, bent on destroying you. But do not fear him.*
- ◆ *Always pray to God and say in every circumstance, "Thy will be done." This will be your anchor and your salvation.*

These are great sayings from a priest who not only preached them, but lived them. And that is why he's a saint! Saint Pio of Pietrelcina, pray for us!

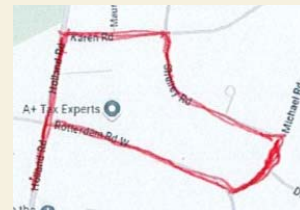

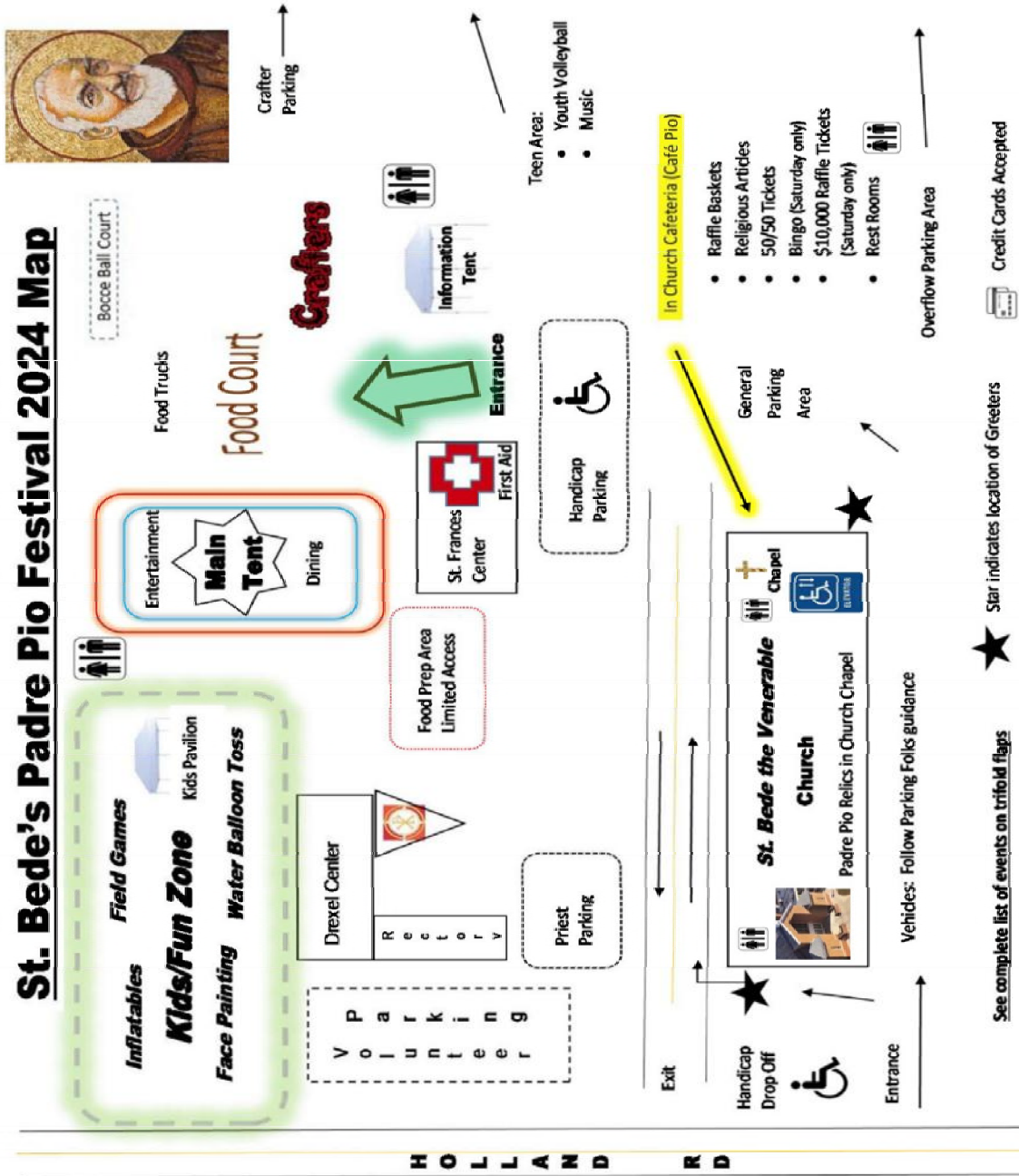
