

### A MESSAGE FROM YOUR PASTOR

My dear parishioners,

This weekend we begin one of the most holy and sacred times in the parish calendar. It's our turn as a parish to celebrate three days, or approximately **Forty Hours** when Jesus in the Most Blessed Sacrament is exposed on the main altar of our church in a special container called the Monstrance. The Monstrance allows us to see the Consecrated Host, which is the Body and Blood of Jesus, made present for us at the 12:30pm Mass, which begins the **Forty Hours Devotion**.

In other words except for times when Mass is celebrated on the altar, the Monstrance will be there over these next three days for visitors and adorers to spend time with Jesus. It is a moment when we look at and adore the Eucharist that we receive so often and unfortunately, too often, just take for granted.

So I invite you, no I encourage you, to make an appointment with the Divine Physician for an hour, half hour, or even just 15 minutes. Often times people ask, "So what should I do, or what can I do during that time? Can you sit? Must you kneel? Is it okay that one person is reading while another seems to be writing something in a notebook?"

Here are some acceptable options you can take in the Presence of Jesus, your Beloved Savior, who will just be so happy to see you. There are no specific rules, just be there. Reflect on His cross and adore Him for all He has done for you and humanity.

Many Catholics use this time in Eucharistic Adoration for praying the rosary. The rosary offers a helpful way to spend a large chunk of time in praying while meditating on the various mysteries of the rosary. Did you forget them? Use your cell phone – it's alright!



For many other Catholics who go to Adoration, writing in a small notebook allows their inner thoughts to come forward. It can help them process their true feelings about a certain matter while in the Presence of Our Savior. It may be fear, anger, confusion, joy, thanksgiving. Different things for different people. Jesus is fine with whatever you bring Him.



Reading is another wonderful activity to do during Eucharistic Adoration. There is sacred scripture reading, which is always time well spent. Or any other devotional or religious book.



The truth is, we live in difficult times. Disease, war in the Middle East, political turmoil and public unrest seem to mar our country. Divisions among political groups are raising tensions and seem like the world is spinning out of control. But as Catholics, we have a hope greater than all these things. And our hope is Jesus, who calls us to spread the Good News of His ultimate victory through the resurrection. This personal journey of impacting the world should begin by recommitting to Eucharistic Adoration. **Forty Hours is the perfect "new beginning."**






